Subject: Call for Projects - 2010 Statewide Transportation Enhancement Program

The Puget Sound Regional Council (PSRC) invites sponsors of eligible projects in King, Kitsap, Pierce and Snohomish counties to submit applications to compete for the \$11,022,000 available through the 2010 Statewide Transportation Enhancements Program. These are federal fiscal year 2010-2011 funds, available through a setaside of the Federal Highway Administration's Surface Transportation Program for transportation-related activities designed to strengthen the cultural, aesthetic, and environmental aspects of the nation's transportation system.

All public agencies and non-profit organizations are eligible to apply, but applicants should note that projects requiring design, right of way acquisition or construction must be sponsored by a public agency. The requirement for a public agency to have Certification Acceptance (CA) status in order to submit an application is waived for this program, but all federal and state project requirements must still be met. No local matching funds are required, and applicants may request up to 100% of the eligible project costs with these federal funds. Funds must be obligated within two years of selection approval.

PSRC will conduct a workshop on June 8, 2010 to provide more specific information on the application process and eligibility requirements for the 2010 Statewide Transportation Enhancement Program.
