SUBJECT: Statewide TOD Study: Expanding Opportunities for Transit-Oriented Development in Washington

IN BRIEF

The committee will hear about research and recommendations for transit-oriented development policies in Washington state.

DISCUSSION

In 2025, the Washington State Legislature continued funding for a study to provide recommendations on how local governments can most effectively implement [HB 1491](#), a TOD bill that passed during the 2025 legislative session.

Yonah Freemark with Urban Institute and Dave Catterson with the Joint Transportation Commission will provide an overview of the most recent research, which is due to the legislature by December 2025.

SUBJECT: Regional Transportation Plan Development Process

IN BRIEF

At the December meeting, the Regional TOD Committee will be briefed on the schedule, work program, and recent progress to develop the next long-range Regional Transportation Plan (RTP). The briefing will focus on TOD-related work to-date, including transit, active transportation, and transit access.

DISCUSSION

Since the September RTOD Committee update on this project, PSRC has continued work to develop the next RTP as follows:

- Staff and the consultant team completed seven regional public meetings, receiving feedback on the future scenarios being modeled that helped inform board decisions on the draft plan.
- The Transportation Policy Board provided direction to PSRC staff on a preferred scenario and the draft plan's financial strategy, leading to a release of the draft plan for public comment in mid-December.

Elements of the Draft RTP that staff will highlight for the RTOD Committee include:

- Active Transportation Plan
- Coordinated Mobility Plan
- Regional gaps in transit service
- The approach to the regional transit access assessment that addresses access needs across modes.

Given that the Draft RTP is expected to be released for public comment the week of the December RTOD Committee meeting, staff will provide the latest information on the public comment period and remaining schedule available at the time of the meeting.

NEXT STEPS

The agency is continuing to engage the Transportation Policy Board on development of the RTP. The draft plan will be released for public comment between mid-December 2025 through end of January 2026. Adoption by the General Assembly is scheduled for May 28, 2026.
