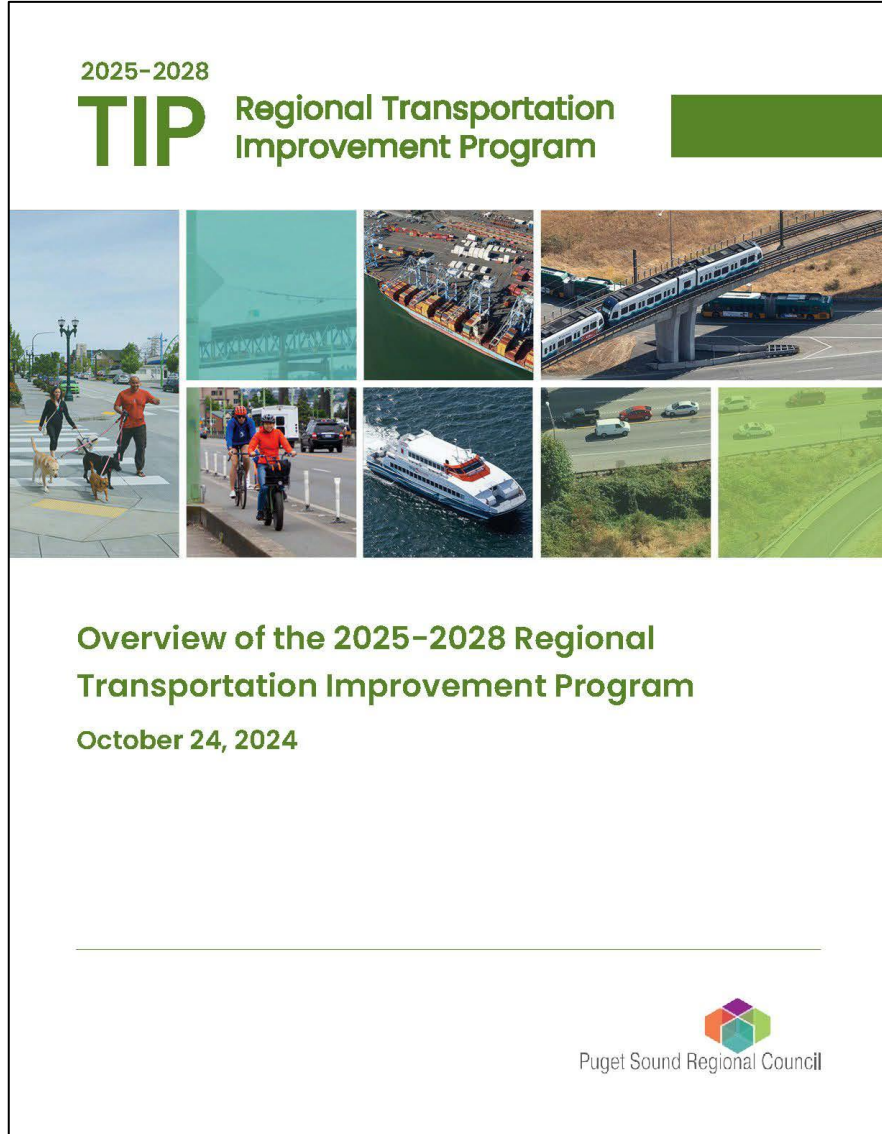

Transportation Improvement Program

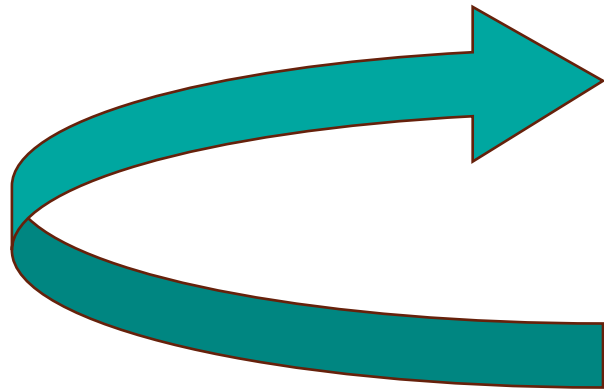
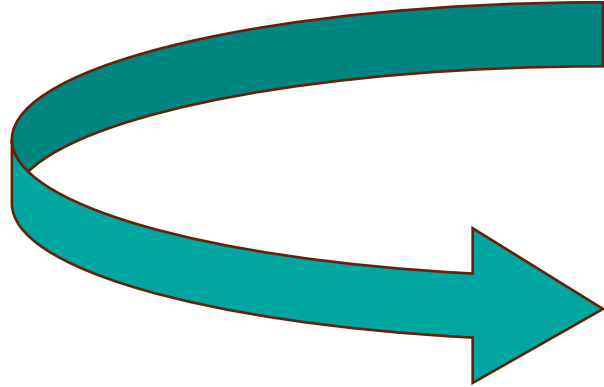


- **636 projects** currently programmed, most include multiple outcomes
- **~\$16 billion** programmed, representing **~\$61 billion** in total investments in the region



TIP Amendments in 2025

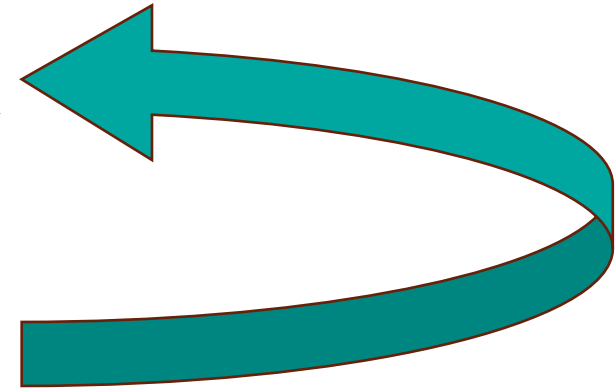
86 new projects

The PSRC region **obligated 65 projects** with a total of **~\$124.8 million** in PSRC-managed FHWA funds

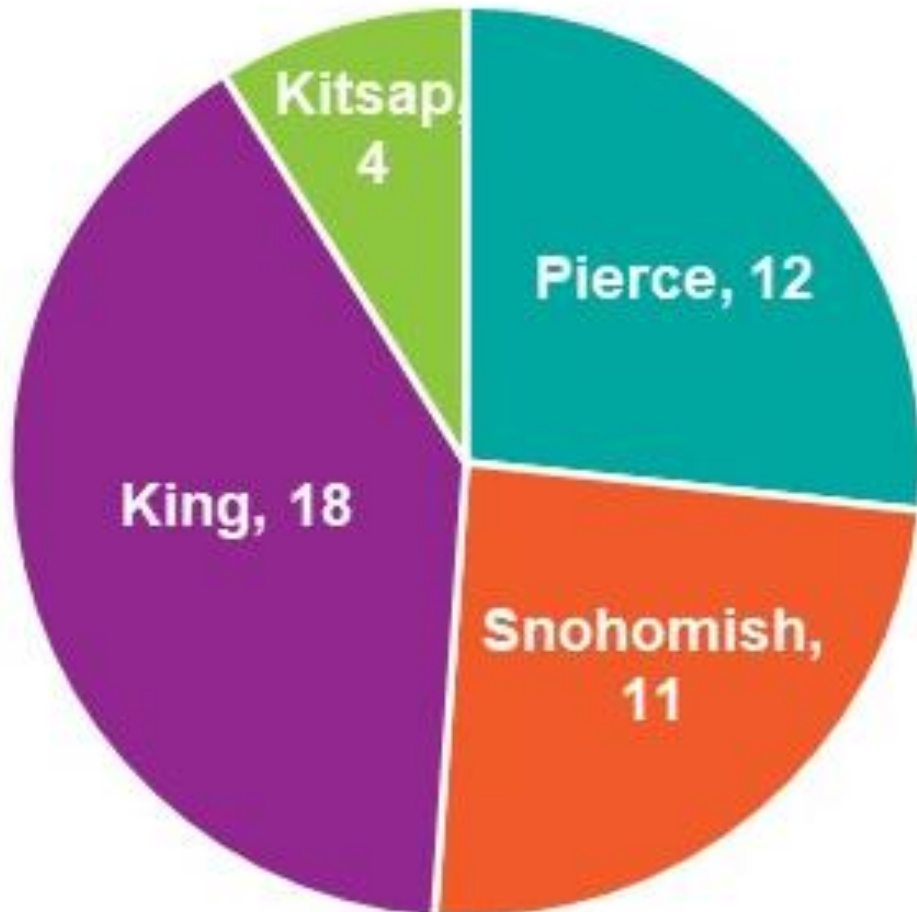
The region received **~\$7M in Redistributed OA**

35 projects with ~\$58.5 million in PSRC-managed FHWA funds completed



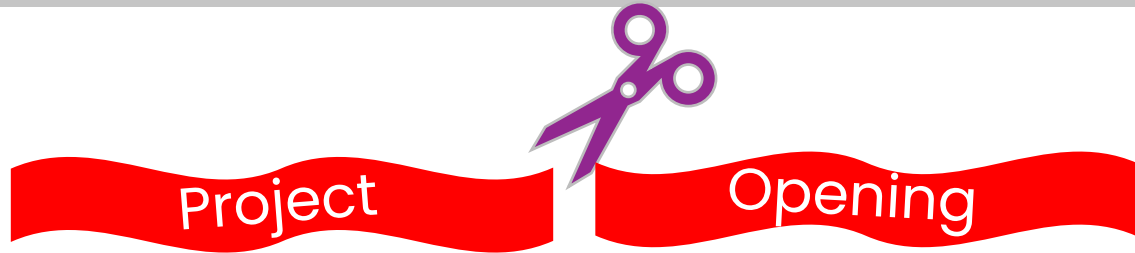
2025 Project Delivery

Looking Ahead, PSRC Efforts in 2026



Transportation Planning work program includes:

- Finalize and adopt the 2026 **Regional Transportation Plan**
- Conduct **Rural Town Centers & Corridors (RTCC)** and **Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP)** funding competitions
- **Deliver projects** with >\$100 million in PSRC managed FHWA funds
- >\$200 million in PSRC managed FTA funds programmed in 2026
