# Transportation Improvement Program




- **636 projects** currently programmed, most include multiple outcomes
- **~\$16 billion** programmed, representing **~\$61 billion** in **total investments** in the region



The PSRC region **obligated 65 projects** with a total of **~\$124.8 million** in PSRC-managed FHWA funds


The region received **~\$7M in Redistributed OA**

- **10 PSRC FTA-funded projects completed**





# Looking Ahead, PSRC Efforts in 2026



Transportation Planning work program includes:

- Finalize and adopt the **2026 Regional Transportation Plan**
- Conduct **Rural Town Centers & Corridors (RTCC) and Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP) funding competitions**
- **Deliver projects with >\$100 million in PSRC managed FHWA funds**
- **>\$200 million in PSRC managed FTA funds programmed in 2026**
