

Upcoming Work Program Activities - Highlights

- RTP Dashboard / Performance Monitoring / Data Collection
 - Annual updates
 - Data includes travel metrics, electric vehicle shares, transit ridership, safety, etc.
 - March board presentation



Upcoming Work Program Activities - Highlights

- Regional Transit Access Assessment
 - Evaluation of transit access opportunities and needs across the region and specific to local contexts
 - Update of tools and resources
 - Development of an online mapping tool



Upcoming Work Program Activities - Highlights

- Consolidated Grant Program Regional Rankings
 - WSDOT grant program for specialized mobility needs
 - Requires agencies like PSRC to provide regional rankings of projects submitted
 - Consistent with regional Coordinated Mobility Plan
 - TPB recommendation December 2026–January 2027



Upcoming Work Program Activities - Highlights

- Safety Activities
 - Continue administrative role of two Safe Streets and Roads for All grants, supporting ~20 local agencies and tribes
 - Annual data collection and performance monitoring
 - Continued technical and outreach assistance in 2026



Upcoming Work Program Activities - Highlights

- Climate Partnerships:
 - Puget Sound Climate Preparedness Collaborative
 - Regional Electric Vehicle Plan
 - South-Central Puget Sound Climate Resilient Communities Accelerator
 - Ongoing coordination with PSCAA on implementation of Comprehensive Climate Action Plan



Upcoming Work Program Activities - Highlights

- Project database and application system upgrades
 - Update to comprehensive database of all projects
 - Tracks funding, progress, completions
 - Update to project application forms
 - Project selection applications
 - Transportation Improvement Program applications
 - Progress report forms
