Federal Updates

- Continuing Resolution through January 30, 2026
- 2 Appropriations Minibus packages
- Affordable Care Act Subsidies



Continuum of Care Changes



- Lawsuit ongoing
- Judge ordered reinstatement of 24-25 NOFO and begin processing renewals
- No funds will be rewarded until final judgment
- Efforts to include language in THUD appropriations bill to require HUD to fund renewals continue

Governor Ferguson's Proposed Operating Budget

- Supports Millionaire's Tax
- Taps \$1b of Rainy Day Fund
- \$569m Climate Commitment Act for Working Families Tax Credit
- Ends tax exemption for data center replacement equipment and prescription warehouses
- Cuts to agencies, higher ed, education, childcare



Housing Investments



- **\$225m Housing Trust Fund**
- **\$500k Housing Agency task Force**
- **\$5m Multifamily building efficiency grants**
- **\$5m Low-income home rehabilitation grants for flood victims**
- **\$4m Home Futures Institute**

Housing Highlights



Impacts of Federal Funding Changes

- 48 lawsuits
- \$15b in federal funding at risk
- \$165m federal funding shifts
- 1 million Washingtonians affected



Governor Ferguson's Proposed Transportation Budget



- \$1b for 3 new ferries
- \$2.1b for maintenance & preservation

Revenue Proposals

- Excise tax on payroll expenses [HB 2100](#) (Scott)/[SB 6093](#) (Saldaña)
- Advanced computing surcharge [HB 1839](#) (Reed)
- Enacting a tax on stocks, bonds, and other financial intangible assets [SB 5797](#) (Frame)



Residential Development in Commercial Zones



SB 6026 (Alvarado)

- Requires residential development to be allowed in commercial zones
- Prohibits requiring ground floor commercial as condition of residential development in commercial/mixed use zones

Resources to Address Continuum of Care

Allowed Uses for Funding for Affordable Housing and Services [SB 6067](#) (Alvarado) [HB 2359](#) (Petersen)

- Flexibility for HB 1590 sales tax
- Extends REET exemption for affordable housing to 24 months

Budget Request \$120m for funding for operations and maintenance for PSH



Siting of PSH/Shelter



SB 6069 (Alvarado)/ HB 2266 (Petersen)

- Must allow transitional housing, PSH, shelter in any area in the UGA not zoned industrial
- Prohibits requiring more restrictive standards for STEP than other types of residential
