 - Mobile friendly design

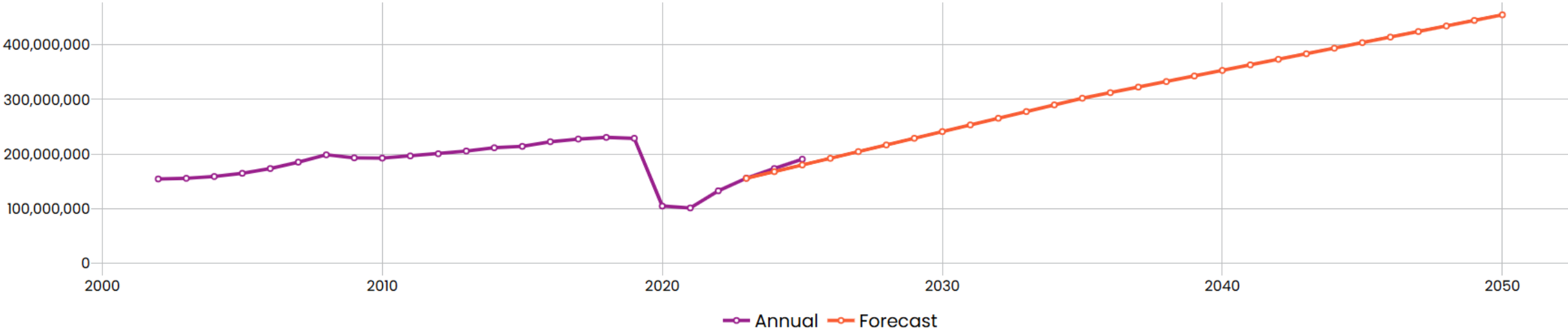

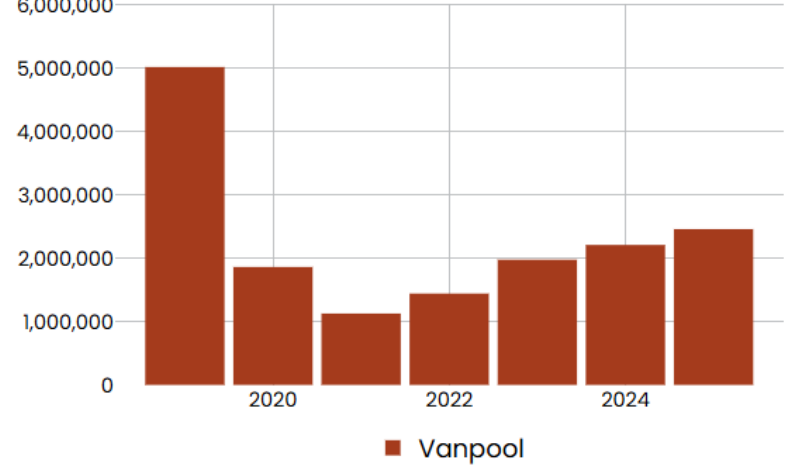
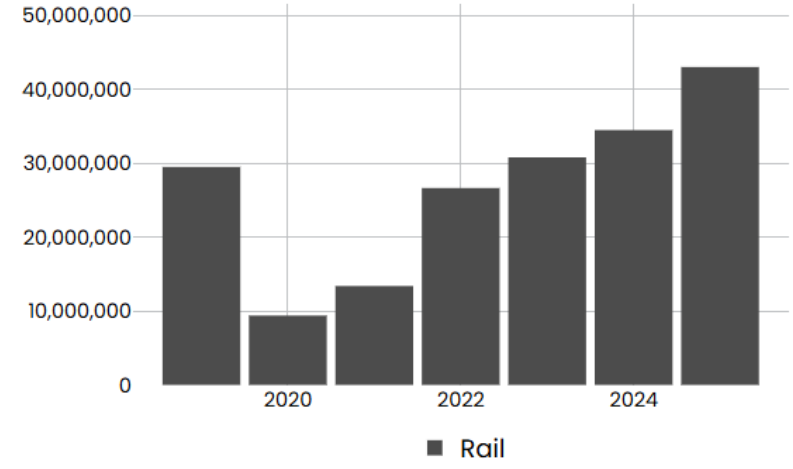
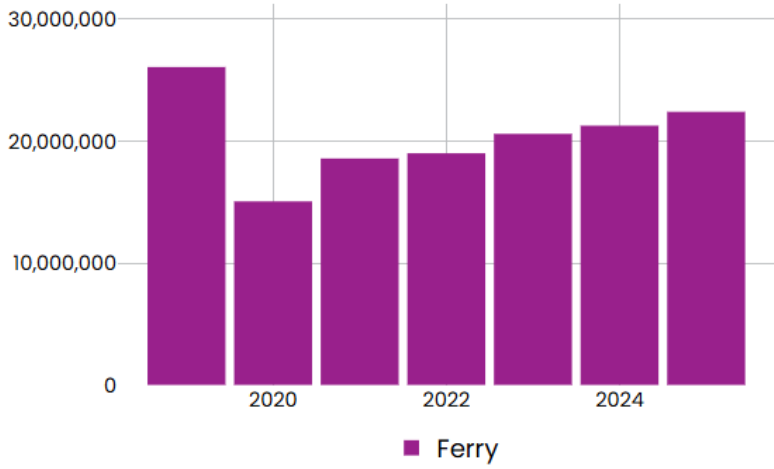
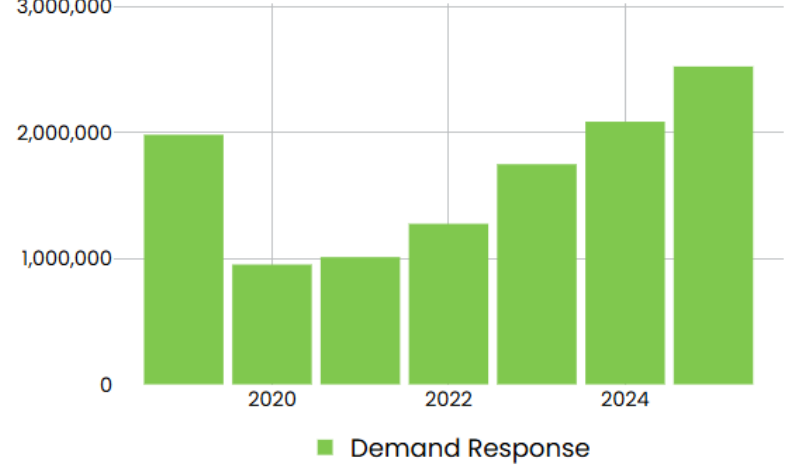

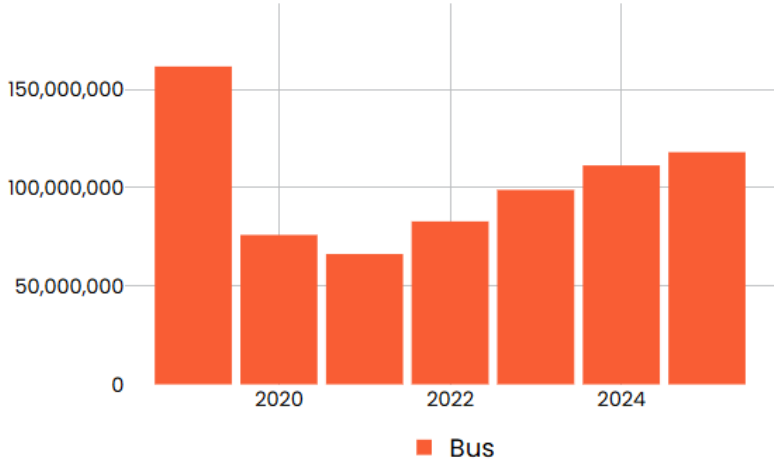

Annual Transit Boardings by Mode

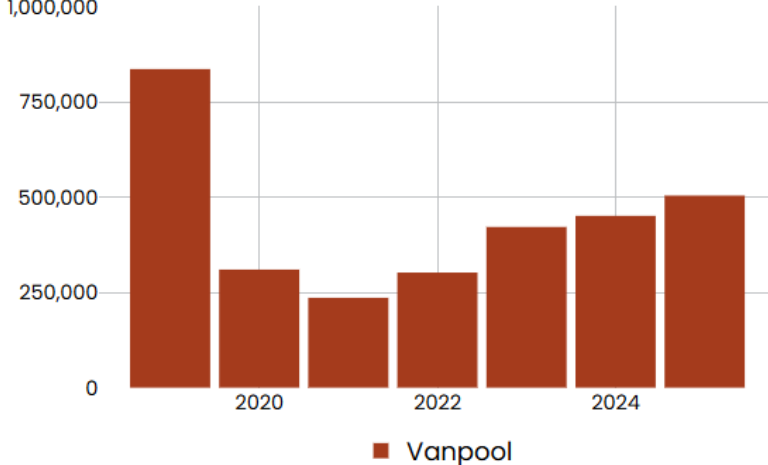
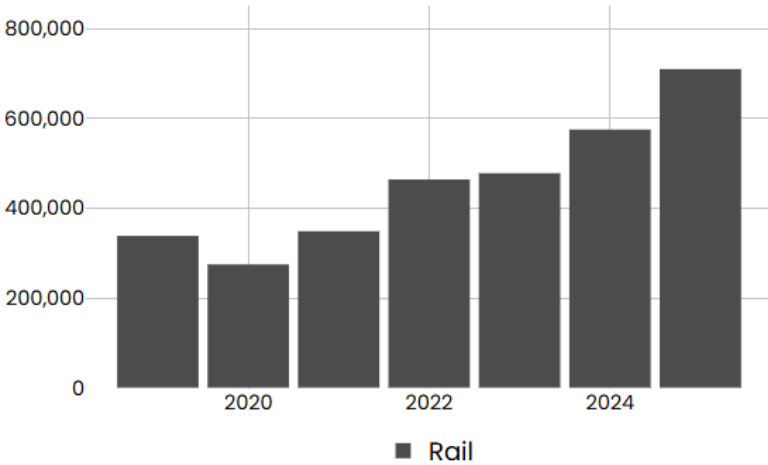
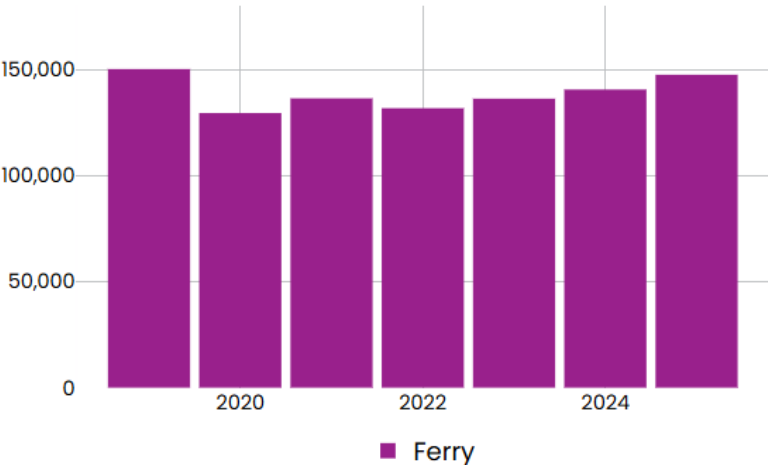
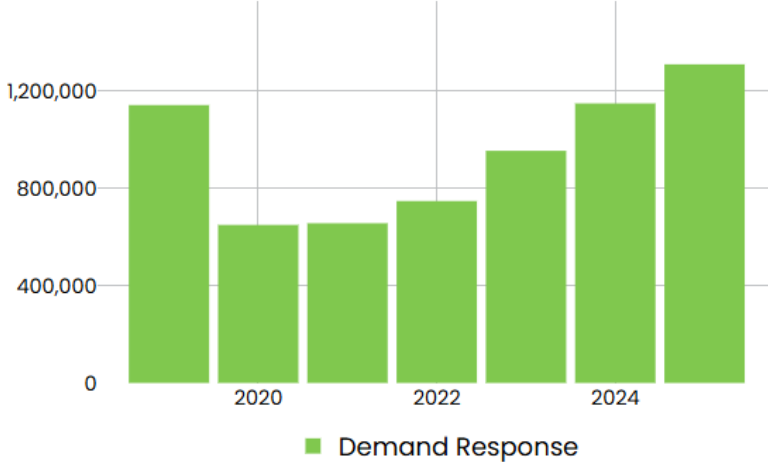
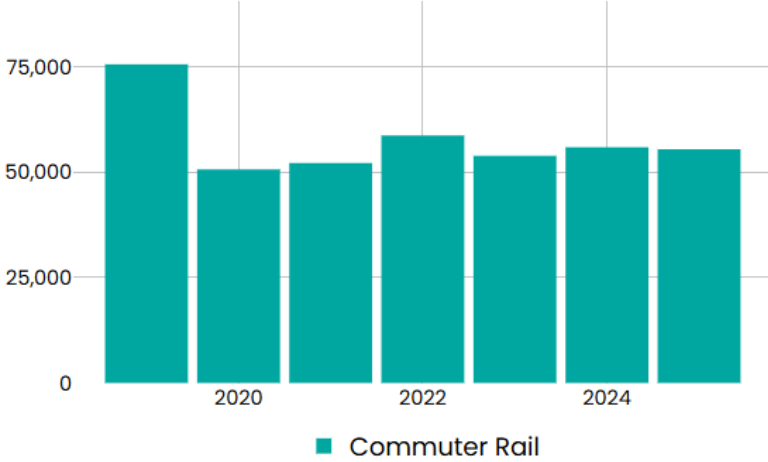
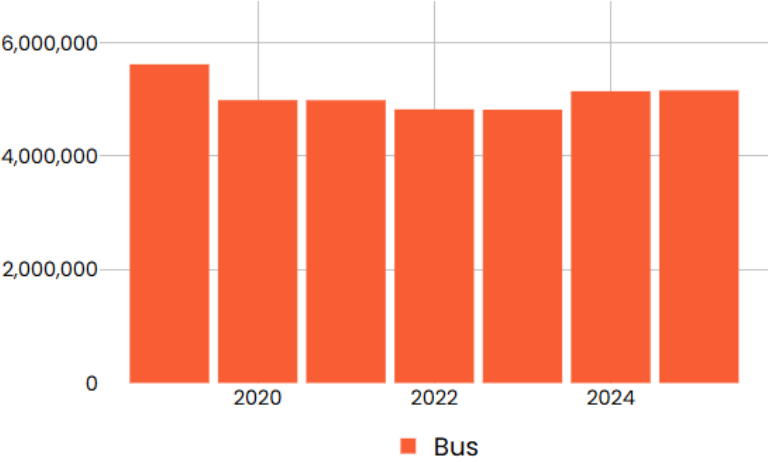
Boardings Revenue-Hours Boardings-per-Hour

Annual Revenue Hours by Mode

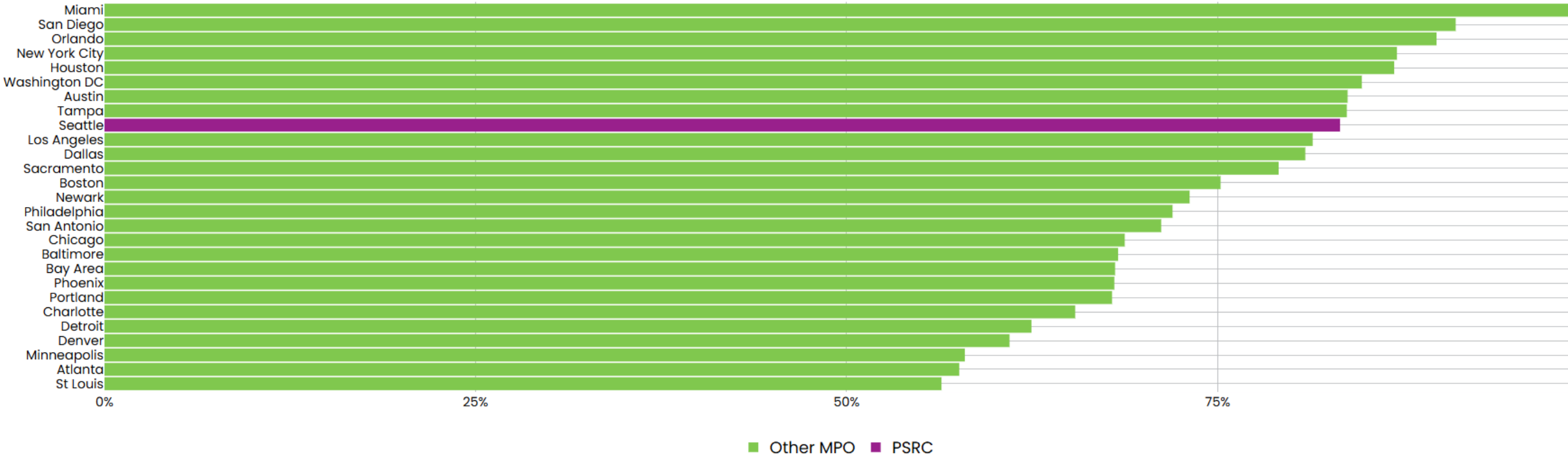

Share of Pre-Pandemic Boardings in 2025

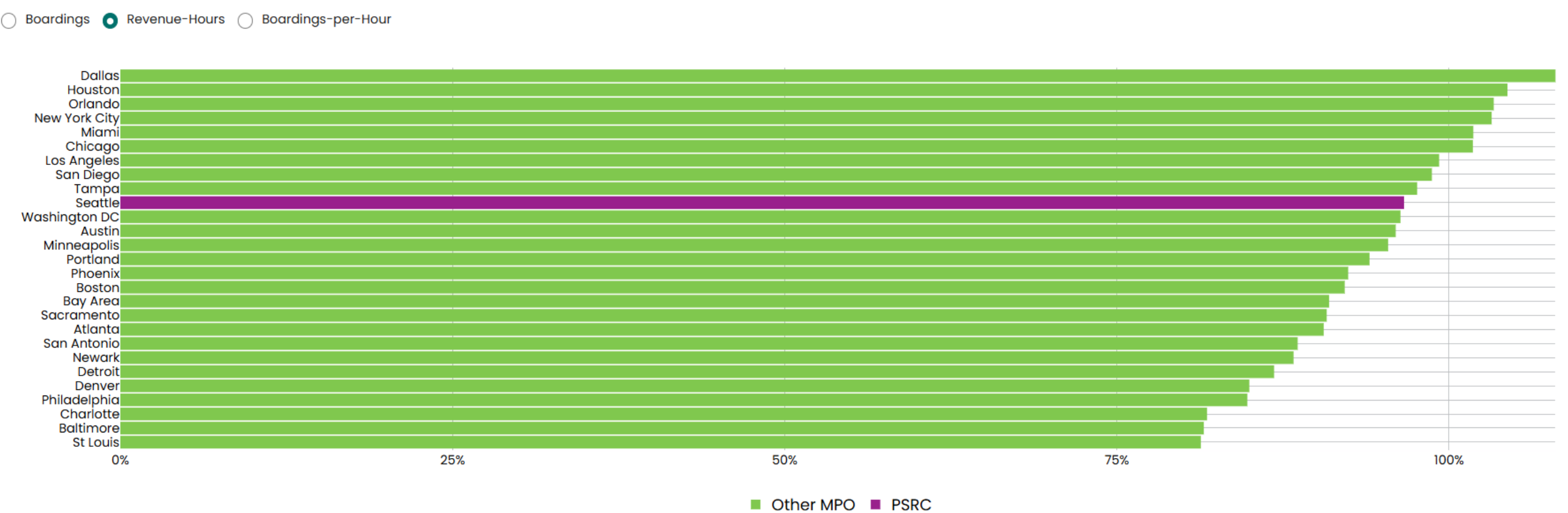
