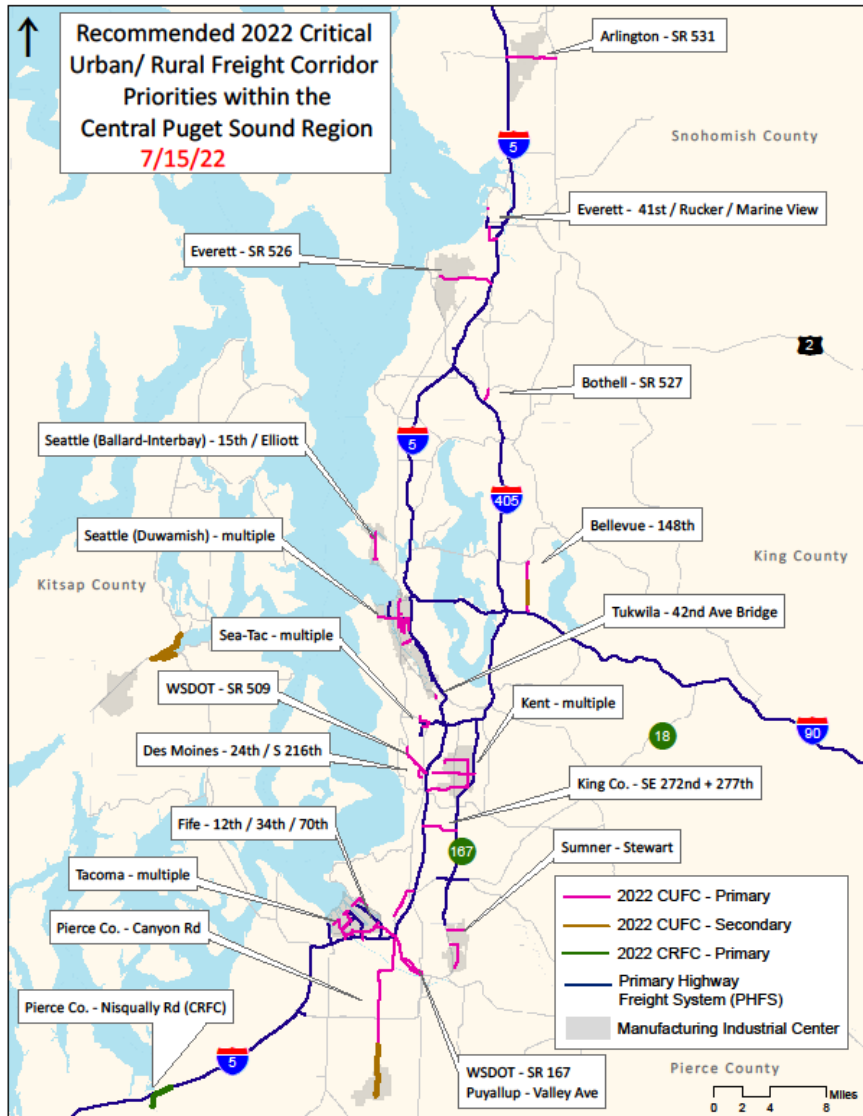


Critical Freight Corridor Designations

- Statewide Critical **URBAN** Freight Corridor (CUFC) mileage cap is 150 miles
 - PSRC is responsible for URBAN corridor designations in the central Puget Sound region
- PSRC's **URBAN** corridor mileage cap is ~71 miles (~47%)
- *Statewide Critical RURAL Freight Corridor (CRFC) mileage cap is 300 miles*



2022 CUFC Designations in the PSRC Region



- 61 CUFC segments designated
- 4 Tiers of priorities –
 - 1) T-1 / T-2 with projects serving MICs / industrial areas
 - 2) T-3 with projects serving MICs / industrial areas
 - 3) T-1 / T-2 without projects
 - 4) T-3 without projects

Remaining balance placed on contingency list



Proposed 2026 CUFC Update Process

1. Remove any segments with projects completed since last designation process
2. If more mileage is still needed, remove additional segments starting with contingency list
3. Keep removing segments from lowest-priority tiers until sufficient mileage is freed up for 2026 NHFP priorities

Next Steps

- **PSRC** – outreach to confirm segments with completed projects
- **WSDOT** – convene Project Selection Committee to select final set of statewide NHFP investments for funding recommendation to the Legislature
- **FAC** – reconvene in June to finalize Critical Freight Corridor designation update to ensure projects recommended for NHFP funding are designated
