Critical Urban Freight Corridor (CUFC) Designation Process

Doug Cox led a discussion about the CUFC designation process, beginning with an overview of the schedule of major milestones.

He noted that the CUFC process is tied to the current National Highway Freight Program (NHFP) project selection process led by WSDOT, as in order to be eligible to receive NHFP funds projects must be either on the Primary National Highway Freight Network (NHFN) or designated as a Critical Freight Corridor.

The committee reviewed the list of 2026 NHFP projects submitted in the region. Doug provided an overview of the existing CUFC corridors and how the corridors were identified and prioritized. He proposed a process for updating the list of corridors that would first remove corridors with completed projects in order to free up sufficient mileage for the 2026 NHFP project corridors.
