2026 CUFC Update Process

1. Remove any segments with projects completed since last designation process
2. If more mileage is still needed, remove additional segments starting with contingency list
3. Keep removing segments from lowest-priority tiers until sufficient mileage is freed up for 2026 NHFP priorities



2026 CUFC Update Process – Results

1. Remove any segments with projects completed since last designation process
 - *Segments with confirmed completed projects –*
 - **Kent** – 84th Ave S; S 212th St
 - **Pierce Co.** – Canyon Rd E (SR 512 to 138th St E)
 - **Seattle** – E Marginal Way S Corridor (North Segment); S Hanford St
2. If more mileage is still needed, remove additional segments starting with contingency list
 - Not needed
3. Keep removing segments from lowest-priority tiers until sufficient mileage is freed up for 2026 NHFP priorities
 - Not needed
