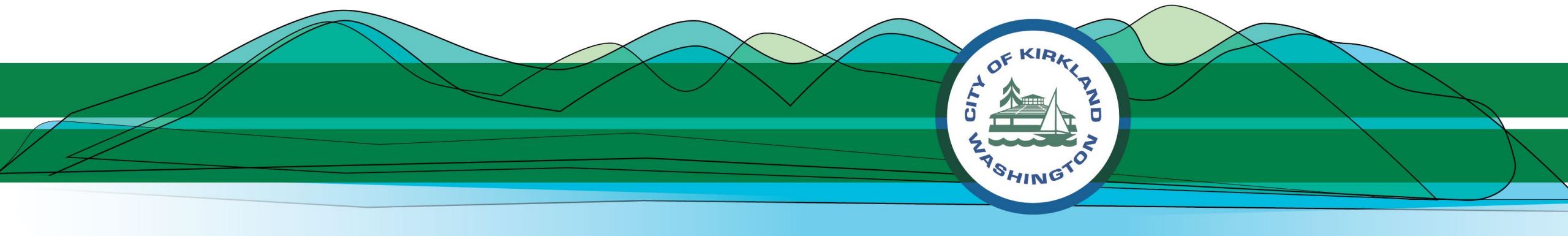

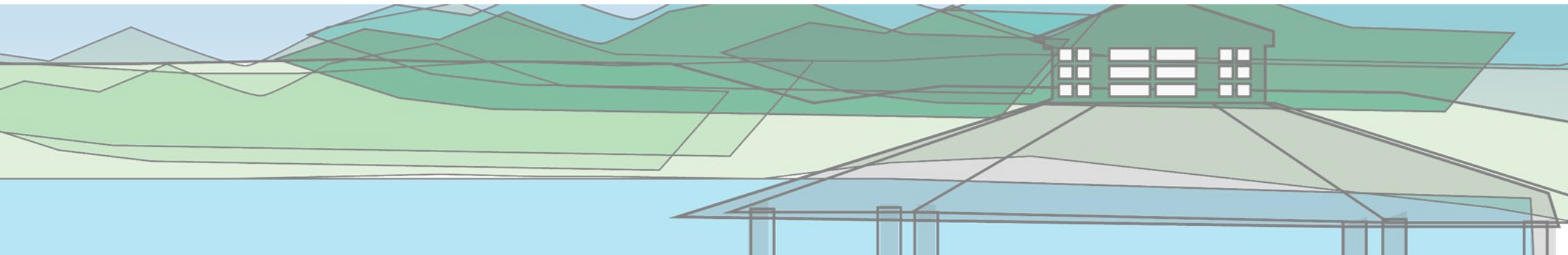

Coordinated Response

Homeless Outreach Coordinator

- Position created in 2023
- Engagement and relationship-building with unhoused residents

Housing Navigation Coordinator

- Position created in 2025
- Support unhoused and vulnerably housed residents access affordable housing



Coordinated Response

Homeless Assistance and Response Team (HART)



Multi-department response network working collaboratively to address needs of unhoused residents.

- Homeless outreach staff
- Neighborhood Resource Officers (Police)
- Mobile Integrated Health (MIH-Fire)
- Crisis Responders (RCR)
- Park Ranger
- Code Enforcement
- Community Court
- Jail Navigator

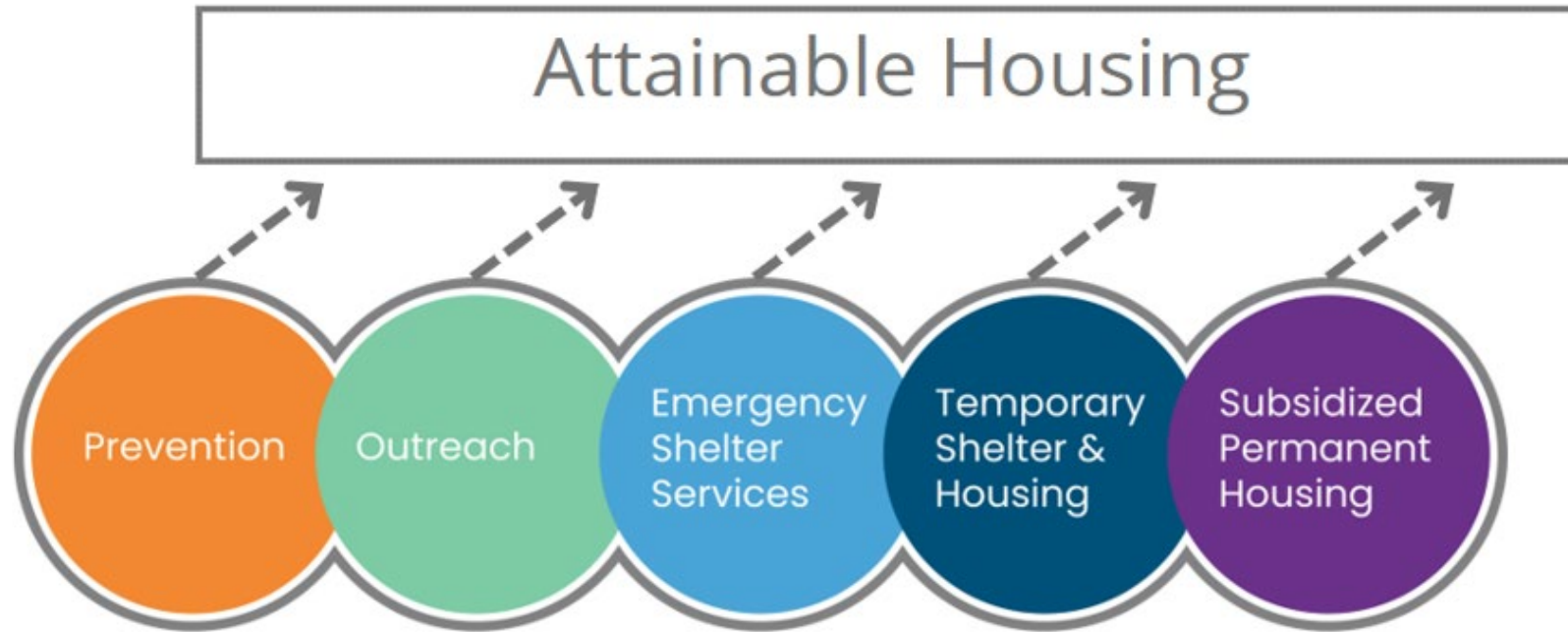

Targeted Core Investments

Homelessness Action Plan

Purpose:

- Prevent homelessness where possible, support unhoused individuals in their transition to stable housing, and provide a compassionate and dynamic response to situations involving residents on a case-by-case basis

77 Actions:

- Ongoing and proposed actions
- Consistent with core investment targets over time

Connected to the Continuum of Care:

- Support overall coordinated system
- Ensure continued effectiveness of HART
