Purpose of Non-Voting Members

- Non-voting members represent community, environmental, or educational organizations to provide unique and/or underrepresented perspectives on bicycle and pedestrian issues to BPAC discussions.
- They do not vote or participate in discussions related to action items.



Non-Voting Members



- Up to 5 non-voting members
- Term Length: 4 years
- Membership is organization-based (not individual-based)



Membership Recruitment Process

- ✓ Seek suggestions from BPAC on potential candidates
- ✓ Reach out to candidates and invite to informational webinar
- ✓ Interested candidates fill out application re: perspective, knowledge, expertise and personal skills
- ❑ Committee members to review candidates and vote
