

Freight Advisory Committee Meeting Summary

Date: January 12, 2022 - 9:30a.m. - 11:00a.m.

Welcome and Introduction to Online Meeting Format

Geri Poor, Chair, welcomed everyone at 9:30 a.m. Roll call was completed to confirm the members and alternates present.

Action: Approval of Meeting Summary

The December 8, 2021 meeting summary was approved as presented.

Discussion: CUFC/CRFC Designation and NHFP Funding Process

Jennifer Barnes, PSRC, provided an overview of the 2022 Critical Urban Freight Corridor (CUFC) and National Highway Freight Program (NHFP) funding process. She provided a briefing on the 2016 freight project list updates provided by members and led the committee discussion on the process to update the Critical Urban Freight Corridor/ Critical Rural Freight Corridor (CUFC/CRFC) designations, and options for submitting a list of projects for consideration in WSDOT's 2022 National Highway Freight Program (NHFP) funding competition.

The committee discussed the process and agreed that it would be reasonable to limit the projects submitted to one application per jurisdiction and be limited to jurisdictions within designated industrial areas. Jennifer said that once all the freight transportation project information is received, PSRC will compile this information into a summary to be discussed at the next Freight Advisory Committee meeting on February 9. She reminded the committee that PSRC will need to submit the completed project submission forms to WSDOT in mid-March and then a list of candidate freight projects will be presented for review by PSRC's Transportation Policy Board and Executive Board at their respective March meetings. She noted more details and information on next steps for project submissions would be forthcoming.
