


All FTA Funding Obligations FY2017-2024





FTA Obligations Summary - Earned Share


FTA Earned Share FY2017-2022






FTA Obligations Summary - Regional Competitive

FTA Regional Competitive FY2017-2024








FTA TrAMS Application Timeline






Regional Funding Competition: Obligation Status FY2017-2024

Transit Project Delay Issues

- The October 2021 progress reports continued to show an increased number of self-reported "behind schedule" projects.
- Most delays were related to the pandemic, including shifting agency priorities, supply chain issues and staffing shortages.
- Sponsors also reported some projects as "on schedule" but project schedule or scope was recently adjusted.



Project Tracking Update

- PSRC has begun reaching out to sponsors if applications have not been submitted 6 months after their creation in TrAMS for regional FTA funds and 3 months after being flexed for FHWA funds.
 - Gather information on reasons for delay
 - Evaluate if potential follow-up needed from PSRC and review by Regional FTA Caucus
