Specialized Transportation

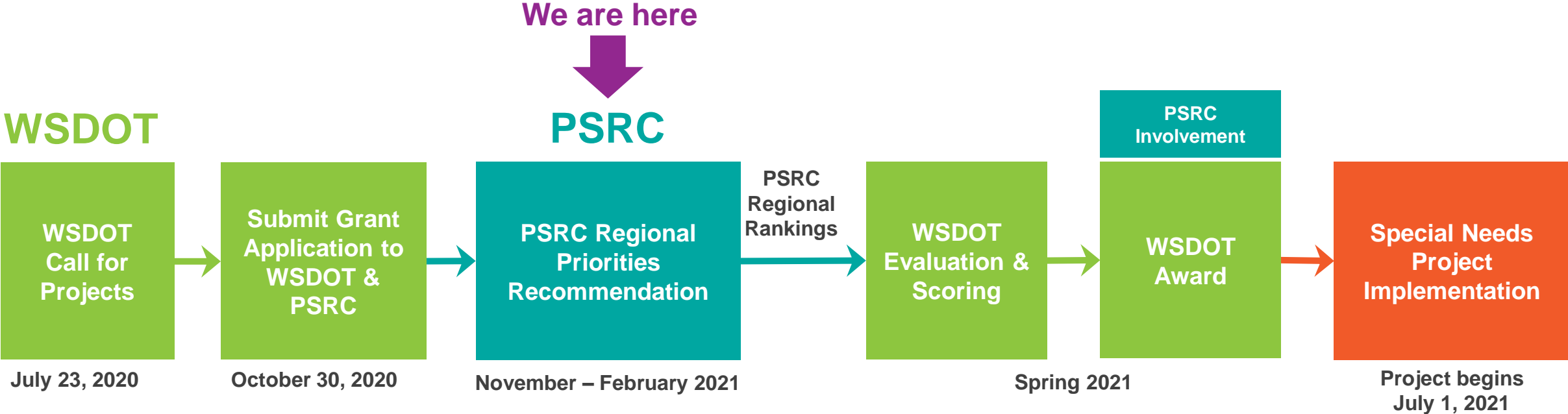
People with special transportation needs include:

WSDOT Consolidated Grant provides funding from a variety of federal and state sources for specialized transportation programs.



Overview of WSDOT Consolidated Grant Process

Allocation of Regional Priority Rankings

- **WSDOT allows projects to apply for 2 or 4 years**
- **21 ABC rankings are available for 2021-23 for PSRC:**
 - 7 A's
 - 7 B's
 - 7 C's
 - Unlimited D's
- **11 projects (\$6.8M) were funded in 2018 for 2021-23 biennium**



Summary of Projects Recommended for Priority Rankings

- **Number of Projects: 13 projects**
- **Total Request:**
 - \$3.2M for 2021-23
 - \$2.7M for 2023-25
- **Project Types:**
 - Operating projects
 - Mobility management
 - Capital (vehicle replacement)
- More than half of the projects are seeking funding for four years
