Regional Centers & Plan Certification

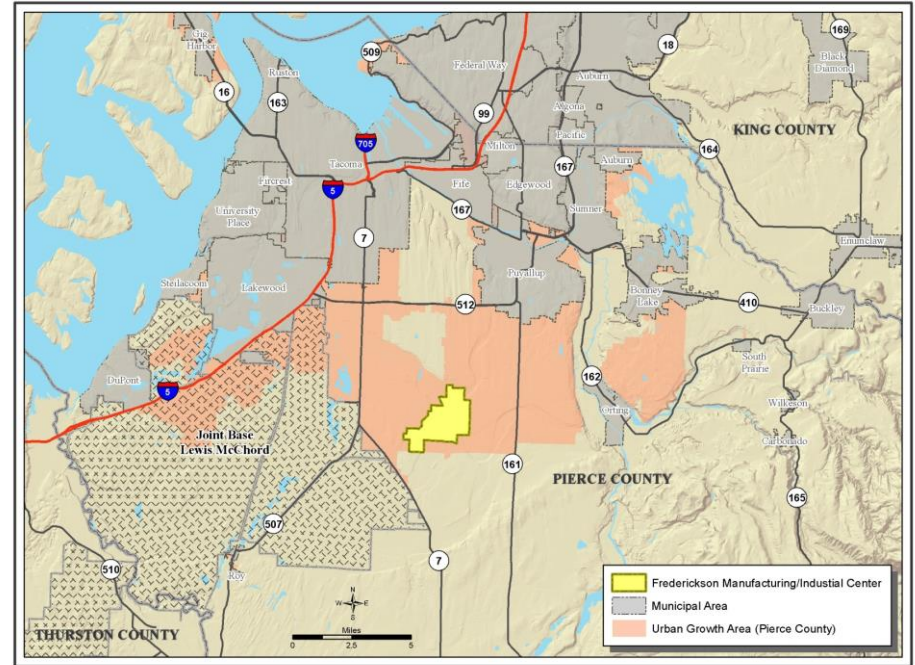


- Review of regional center plans began in 2003
- Ongoing coordination with jurisdictions as plans are done
- Certified subarea plan by 2025



Frederickson MIC

- Located at southern end of region in unincorporated Pierce County
- Produces a wide range of goods
 - aircraft components, carbon composites, construction materials, and packaged foods



Frederickson Community Plan

- Designated by PSRC in 2002
- Plan highlights include:
 - Preservation of industrial land and encouragement of new growth
 - Encourages the use of new technologies and strategies that minimize impacts
 - Acknowledgement of surrounding community and mitigation of impacts
