

 HB 1220 language in the Implementation Table expanded to note the need for funding for local jurisdictions

#### NIMBYism

• Implementation Table updated to include expanded language on community engagement

#### Housing Near Transit

Supply strategy updated to emphasize the need to prioritize land for people and housing

#### Unhoused People

 Narrative now includes additional language on the connection between the lack of affordable housing and an increase in unhoused people, particularly people of color

## Racial Equity

The racial equity statement has been reworded to be more action oriented
