In August 2018, Executive
Dammeier, Mayor Woodards, and
County Councilmember Ladenburg
hosted the 'Mayoral Forum on
Housing Affordability'

Commissioned "State of Housing Affordability in Pierce County" report and hired consultant.

In October 2021 the Intergovernmental Agreement, creating the South Sound Housing Affordability Partners (SSHA³P) was signed by 14 original governments.

SSHA³P hired first staff member in April and added 15th member in May

ABOUT SSHA³P

The South Sound Housing Affordability Partners (SSHA³P) is a voluntary collaboration among 15 governments to work together to create and preserve affordable, attainable, and accessible housing throughout Pierce County.

The draft 2022 work plan outlines 5 strategic priorities

- 1. Develop and support policies and programs that prioritize and incentive residential production
- 2. Refine understanding of affordable housing solutions and promising practices
- 3. Assist member governments in achieving affordable and attainable production and preservation goals
- 4. Ensure our community's affordable, attainable, and accessible housing needs are represented
- 5. Complete the organizational aspects of the SSHA³P intergovernmental entity.





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
