#### **CALL TO ORDER**

The meeting was called to order at 10:02 a.m. by Chair Prince.

#### COMMUNICATIONS AND PUBLIC COMMENT

Alex Tsimerman provided public comment on the information item on institutional and structural racism.

### **CHAIR'S REPORT**

Chair Prince shared that Pierce County Councilmember Hans Zeiger left his position with the Pierce County Council and the new member from Pierce County is Councilmember Paul Herrera. Chair Prince thanked Councilmember Zeiger for his service to the board and welcomed Councilmember Herrera. Chair Prince announced that three non-voting seats expire at the end of the year. Chair Prince and Vice Chair Dunn shared information from an Executive Board Steering Committee meeting about the transportation work program.

### **DIRECTOR'S REPORT**

Director of Growth Management Paul Inghram shared that PSRC has launched a new website. Mr. Inghram announced upcoming events including the TOD for All event on October 21 and the joint board session on institutional and structural racism on November 30. Mr. Inghram highlighted the Governor's Smart Communities Award winners including the cities of Bellevue, Kenmore, Lakewood, Renton, and Seattle.

### **VISION 2050 IMPLEMENTATION STATUS AND TRENDS**

Mr. Inghram presented a progress report on the implementation of VISION 2050. The progress report includes a look at the different chapters in VISION 2050 and the progress to-date on actions and policies. Director of Data Craig Helmann presented on Puget Sound data trends including population, housing, jobs, and transportation trends.

# PLAN CERTIFICATION AND HOUSING

Mr. Inghram provided an overview of plan review and certification including a recap of the July board discussion on housing in the plan review process. Principal Planner Laura Benjamin presented on plan certification and housing goals. Ms. Benjamin reviewed the updated state law for housing elements (HB 1220) and what it means for local updates along with the role of PSRC in including the state requirements as part of plan review.

## **PASSPORT TO 2044 WORKSHOP SERIES**

Senior Planner Maggie Moore provided an update on the Passport to 2044 Workshop Series. Past session topics include a comprehensive planning overview and climate. More topic-specific webinars are planned for the remainder of 2022 and into 2023. PSRC guidance documents and element guides were highlighted along with other resources.
