The meeting was called to order at 10:03 a.m. by Chair Prince.

CHAIR'S REPORT

Chair Prince announced that registration is now open for General Assembly scheduled for Thursday, May 26, and reminded the board about the save the date notice for the joint board workshop on racial equity scheduled for Thursday, June 23, from 10:30 a.m. – 12:00 p.m.

Chair Prince shared Director of Growth Management Paul Inghram and Washington State Department of Commerce's Dave Andersen were both unavailable for today's meeting and each of their agenda items would be postponed. Chair Prince introduced Executive Director Josh Brown for the Director's Report.

DIRECTOR'S REPORT

Executive Director Josh Brown announced the Executive Board unanimously recommended the Regional Transportation Plan, and it will be going to the General Assembly for final action. The General Assembly will be a hybrid meeting with limited number of seats in the PSRC boardroom. The expectation is most of the membership will join virtually. Mr. Brown also highlighted the upcoming joint board workshop on

implicit bias scheduled on June 23 at 10:30 a.m., following the Executive Board meeting.

Mr. Brown announced PSRC has a new member of the leadership team. Robin Koskey started as the new Government Relations and Communications Director. Mr. Brown shared that Ms. Koskey will help support PSRC's development of a legislative agenda to be adopted by the Executive Board.
