CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order at 10:02 a.m. by Chair Prince.

COMMUNICATIONS AND PUBLIC COMMENT

None provided at the meeting. Staff noted that written public comments regarding Black Diamond's comprehensive plan were included in the meeting packet.

CHAIR'S REPORT

Chair Prince announced the appointment of Snohomish County Council Chair Megan Dunn as Vice Chair of the Growth Management Policy Board.

Chair Prince welcomed new board members and alternates:

- Councilmember Sarah Perry and Councilmember Dave Upthegrove are the new members representing King County.
- For Other Cities & Towns in Kitsap County, Councilmember Jon Quitslund of City of Bainbridge Island is the new member and Councilmember Jay Rosapepe of City of Port Orchard is the new alternate.
- For Other Cities & Towns in Snohomish County, Mayor Pro Tem Bryan Wahl of Mountlake Terrace has moved from alternate to member. Mayor Pro Tem Stephanie Vignal of Mill Creek and Councilmember Erin Murray of Mountlake Terrace will serve as alternates.
- For Thurston Regional Planning Council, Helen Wheatley has moved from alternate to member and Mayor Joe DePinto of Yelm is the new alternate.

DIRECTOR'S REPORT

Director of Growth Management Paul Inghram welcomed new board members and alternates. Mr. Inghram announced that at the request of the City of Black Diamond,

the certification of their comprehensive plan was not included on this month's agenda. Mr. Inghram highlighted the two information items in the agenda packet – the VISION 2050 Award Nomination flyer and the General Assembly save the date flyer. General Assembly is scheduled as a hybrid event for May 26, 2022, from 10:00 AM - 1:00 PM.

CONSENT AGENDA

a. Approve Minutes of Growth Management Policy Board Meeting held February 3, 2022

RECOMMEND CERTIFICATION OF THE FEDERICKSON MIC SUBAREA PLAN

Senior Planner Maggie Moore provided an overview of regional centers and the plan certification process. Ms. Moore highlighted the work Pierce County has put into the subarea plan including the preservation of industrial land and encouragement of new growth, encouraging the use of new technologies and strategies that minimize impacts, and acknowledgement of surrounding community and mitigation of impacts.

<u>ACTION</u>: It was moved and seconded (Wahl/Robinson) to recommend the Executive Board certify that the Frederickson MIC subarea plan addresses planning expectations for regional manufacturing/industrial centers. Motion passed.

REGIONAL HOUSING STRATEGY UPDATE

Senior Planner Laura Benjamin updated the board on the Regional Housing Strategy. The Executive Board and Equity Advisory Committee reviewed the strategy and provided additional input. The Executive Board adopted the strategy on February 24, 2022. Ms. Benjamin highlighted three key projects slated for early implementation are monitoring, developing typology, and supporting the plan review updates.

OUTREACH AND SUPPORT FOR 2024 COMPREHENSIVE PLAN UPDATES

Senior Planner Maggie Moore provided an overview of the plan review process and the timeline for the local comprehensive plan updates. Support PSRC will be providing includes the plan review manual, survey, webinar, workshops with Washington State Department of Commerce and MRSC, and meeting one-on-one or presenting at council meetings.
