1. Project Type	Supports existing mobility management programs.
2. PSRC's Coordinated Mobility Plan	 Need #3: More information about available services <i>Vital component of Strategy 3.1:</i> Conduct and tailor mobility management programs Need #7: Better regional coordination to meet growing mobility needs Future CMP updates
3. Uniqueness Evaluation Method of Service	Coordinates methodology across region, eliminating duplication.
4. Financial Sustainability	 20% match, meeting federal requirement. State dollars may be used instead (5% match).
