Introductions and Announcements

Doug McCormick, Chair, welcomed everyone at 9:30 a.m. He then took a roll call to confirm the members and alternates present. Doug and Clint Ritter, Pierce County, acknowledged the recent passing of Russ Blount, Vice Chair, and spoke about Russ's many accomplishments and dedication to his community and region. The committee held a moment of silence in Russ's honor.

Discussion: Project Tracking and Delivery Updates

Kelly McGourty, PSRC, provided an update on 2022 delivery and reported that the region's delivery target was not met this year. She provided some background on the issues, and reminded the committee of the various steps in play towards achieving delivery each year including the annual rebalancing process, reporting on progress reports, the extensions process, etc. She then provided information on planned

activities by staff to increase communication and monitoring of projects, and information that will feed into the upcoming delivery working group to discuss options for improving future delivery and addressing last minute issues. Stephanie Tax, WSDOT, provided additional background information and details from the WSDOT perspective, noting the large amount of other federally funded projects in the region that also require delivery each year.

Kelly reviewed a draft schedule of these upcoming activities, and she will work with the RPEC and Countywide Chairs on the solicitation of members for the working group.
