Keep the Region Moving

- Sustain the transportation investments
- Develop an equitable road usage charge
- Maintain agreed upon state and local funding split decisions

Increase Housing Choices and Affordability

- Supply: Build more housing of different types
- Stability: Provide opportunities for residents to live in housing that meets their needs
- Subsidy: Create and sustain long-term funding sources to create and preserve affordable housing

Significantly Reduce Greenhouse Gas Emissions

- Transit-focused land use
- Multimodal transportation choices
- Pricing the transportation system
