

# 2023 Project Delivery - DRAFT

### Project Extensions:

- 45-Day Extensions: \$17.5m total
- 1-Year Extensions: \$32.4m total
- 1 Exception request: \$1.85m
- Returned funds / deobligations to date = \$5.1m
- Gap to target = \$31.6m



Delivery status to

date = <7%

## Rebalancing Steps

- Projects offering to advance = \$20.6m
- ➤ Gap to target = ~\$11.0m
- PSRC proposal of \$10m buffer
  - Previous years' buffers have been between ~\$4m-\$7m
  - Higher amount modestly addresses lower OA / higher apportionment levels
  - Still allows board conversation on potential additional future funds at higher levels



## Rebalancing Steps

- Immediately ready to go contingency projects = \$40m
  - More than needed, even with buffer (~\$21m)
  - Will fund TAP first, due to higher TAP allocations
  - Then standard proportional distribution between regional (50%) and countywide forums (50%, by population)

- Finalizing extension requests
- Confirming advancing projects can meet July 15<sup>th</sup> deadline
- Confirming eligible contingency list projects can meet July 15<sup>th</sup> deadline
- April board action on extensions, supplemental funding to contingency lists
