

#### Plan Review and Certification

#### What are PSRC's review standards and what planning resources are available?

PSRC works with local governments to ensure that planning is coordinated and meets regional and states requirements. This includes review for consistency with the multicounty planning policies (MPPs) in VISION 2059, the transportation components of the Growth Management Act, and the Regional Transportation Planning. While PSRC with review and provide comments on a jurisdiction's entire comprehensive plan, the focus areas for certification include policy areas with a nexus with transportation planning. PSRC's Plan Review Manage provides information about the process, certification standards, and consistency tools for different types of plans.
