What We're Exploring

- Exploring how to give EAC more influence behind their recommendations
- Currently, only members vote on boards. Potentially amend by-laws to allow EAC to vote.
- Move closer to PSRC's definition of equity:
 - "Those affected by poverty, communities of color, and historically marginalized communities are engaged in decision-making processes, planning, and policy making."
- Vote to determine who will represent EAC at board





What the Boards Do?

Growth Management Policy Board (GMPB)

- Members represent cities, counties, Tribes, ports, transit agencies, etc.
- Advises Executive Board on how to manage population growth (e.g., how much housing do we need and where do we need it).
- Monthly hybrid meeting on the 1st Thursday from 10 a.m. 12 p.m. (Except Aug and Dec)

Transportation Policy Board (TPB)

- Members represent cities, counties, Tribes, ports, transit agencies, etc.
- Advises Executive Board on various transportation issues (e.g., transportation project selection process).
- Monthly hybrid meeting on the 2nd Thursday from 9:30 a.m.–
 11:30 a.m. (Except Aug and Dec)

- 3rd Place: Choose board serve as alternate for
- 4th Place: Serves as alternate on the other board
