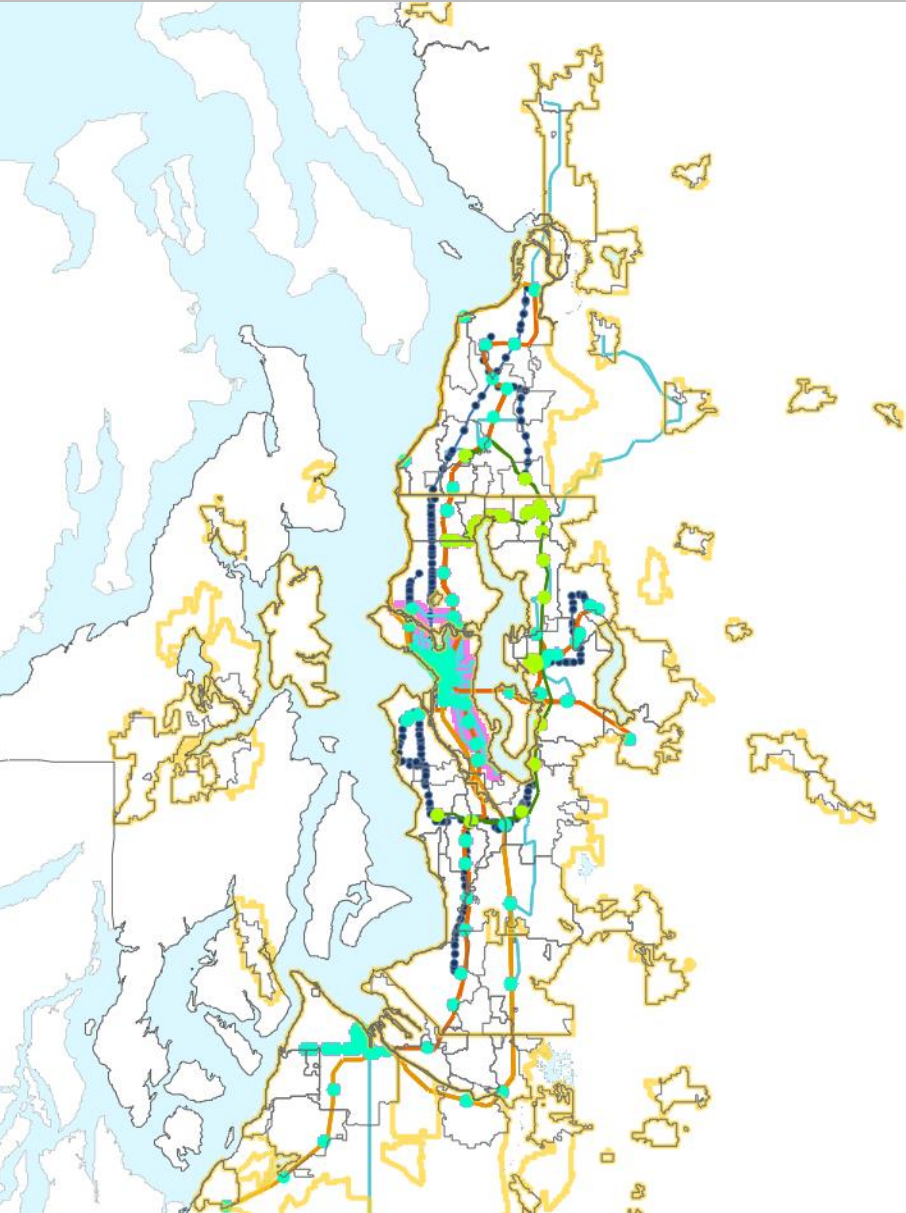

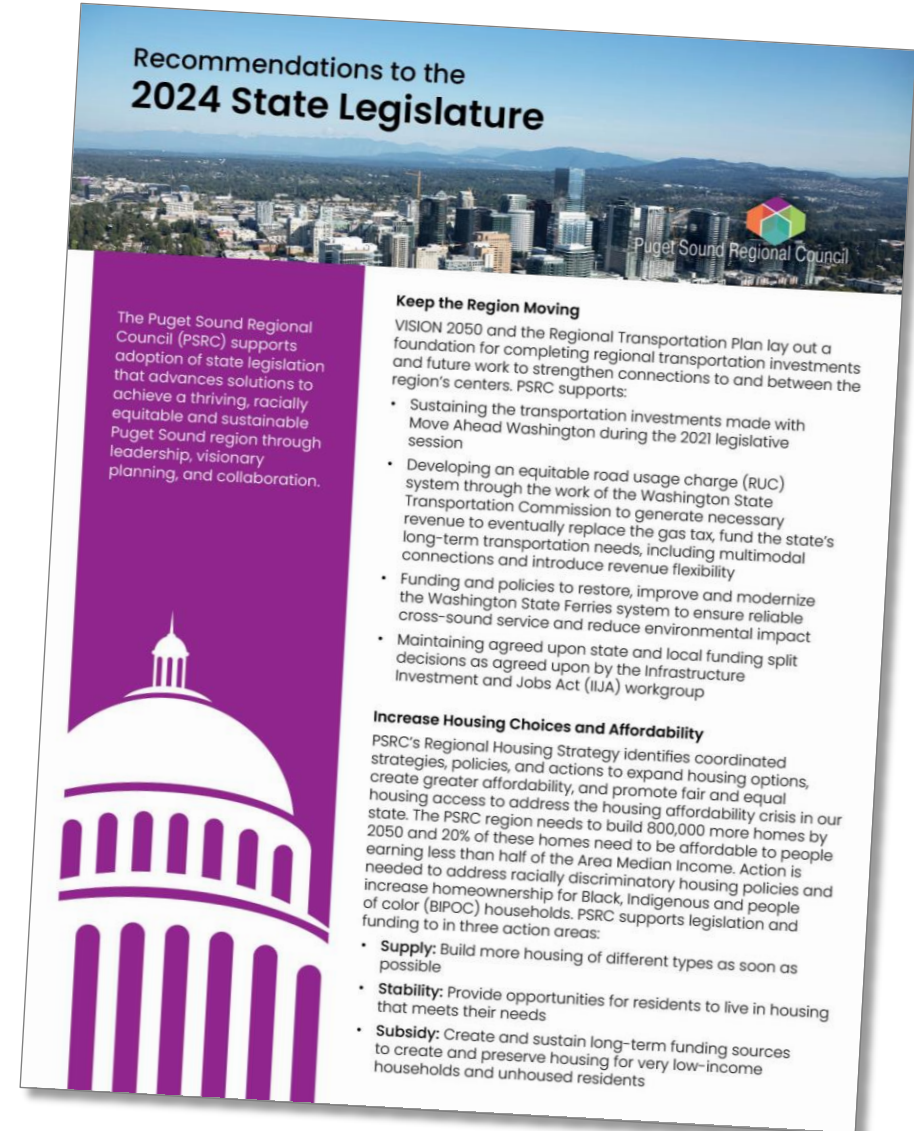

- Sustain a Strong Economy





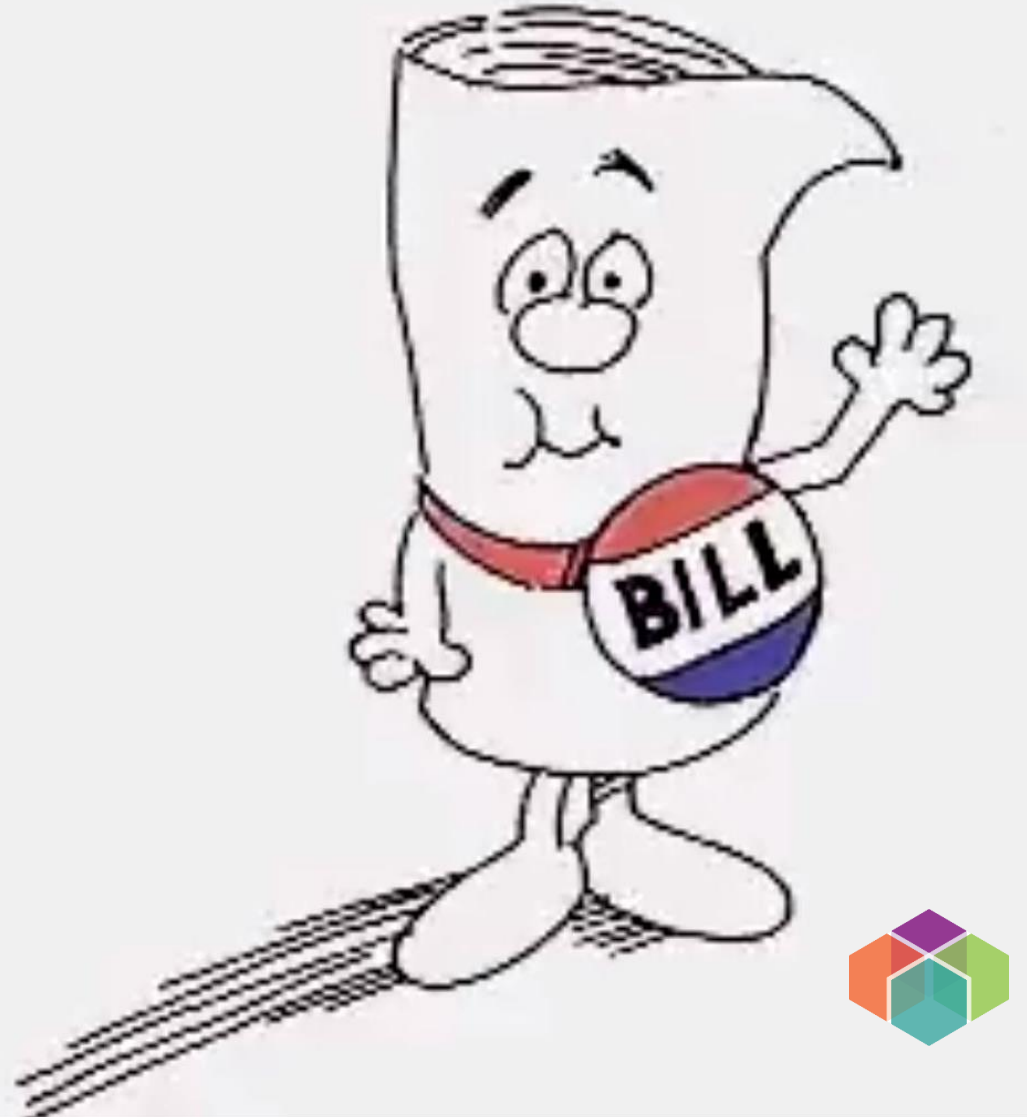
# Changes in the 2024 Recommendations

- **Housing:** added BIPOC Homeownership
- **Economy:** added Economic Development District Priorities:
  - Workforce development
  - Critical infrastructure including broadband
  - Clean energy industry technology
