Coordinated Mobility Plan's Inventory of Services

- Inventory of services is a Federal and State requirement for the Coordinated Transit-Human Services Transportation Plan.
- Inventory should describe existing services and resources.
- Inventory aids local planning and coordination efforts. It also helps identify underserved areas and any duplication in services.



2021 Specialized Transportation Inventory Survey

- Online survey conducted early 2021.
- Comprehensive outreach to service providers in partnership with Hopelink and mobility managers.



- Service Information (service type, hours, eligibility, base fares, contact information, etc.)
- Service Area
- Common Origins and Destinations
- Mobility Needs & Goals
- COVID Impact on Services
- Usage Data (via Follow-up)







Existing Efforts

- Hopelink's Find a Ride Trip Planner
- WSDOT GTFS-Flex Development

Opportunities:

- Engage and collect information from Kitsap County partners.
- Regionwide data collection to address the mobility needs of priority populations covered in the plan.
- Identify the most needed areas not well served by existing services including transit, MOD, and others.
