Applicants are requested to note in the "Other Consideration" section of the Funding Application if the project would be able to accept funds in 2025 or 2026.

### Things you need to prepare your application:

- ✓ The adopted policy focus for PSRC's federal funds is to support the development of centers and the corridors that serve them. For the countywide competition for PSRC's FHWA funds, centers are defined as locally designated centers or regional growth and regional manufacturing/industrial centers.
- ✓ To be eligible to receive PSRC funding, projects must be in, or consistent with, the transportation element of the appropriate city or county plan which has been updated consistent with RCW 36.70A.130 and certified, or conditionally certified, by PSRC.
- ✓ Project Information (Title, description, contact information)
- ✓ Certification Acceptance
- ✓ Federal Functional Classification (A roadway must be approved on the federally classified roadway system before projects on it may use federal funds including new facilities, unless they are an exception such as bicycle or pedestrian projects, projects not on a roadway or using CMAQ funds, any transit project including equipment purchases and park & ride lots)
- ✓ Addresses the Countywide Project Evaluation Criteria
- ✓ Full Project Finance Plan, Schedule, and Delivery

Applications must provide complete information on the project's financial status and implementation schedule by identifying the PSRC grant request and the project's total estimated cost and funding source(s) by phase.

Applicants will identify the phase for which PSRC funds are being requested, the funding source, the amount, and expected year of obligation. The following is important information that pertains to PSRC funding requests.

Project Phase Requests: Given the stringent expectations for project delivery and the potential risk of losing FHWA funds, sponsors applying for FHWA funds may request funding for single project phase - either preliminary engineering, right of way or construction phase. In addition, please be aware of the maximum amounts that may be requested per each application, may differ between the regional and countywide competitions. The requested PSRC funds plus the identified match funds must fully fund the phase.

Expected Year of Obligation: PSRC will distribute FFY 2027-2028 funds. Given the requirement to balance awards by year, applicants will be asked to select their first and second choice for the obligation year - 2027 or 2028.

Obligation Requirements: To align with annual delivery expectations, PSRC's FHWA funds must obligated by June 1<sup>st</sup> of the program year selected. A minimum of 13.5% of local matching funds is required for PSRC's FHWA funding.

- ✓ Estimated Total Project Cost and Schedule (past, current, and future sources, amounts and completion dates for all project phases).
- ✓ Financial Documentation (match funds needed to fully fund and implement the requested phase must be demonstrated to be <u>secured or reasonably expected</u>).
- ✓ Application forms will be available on PSRC's website soon.
