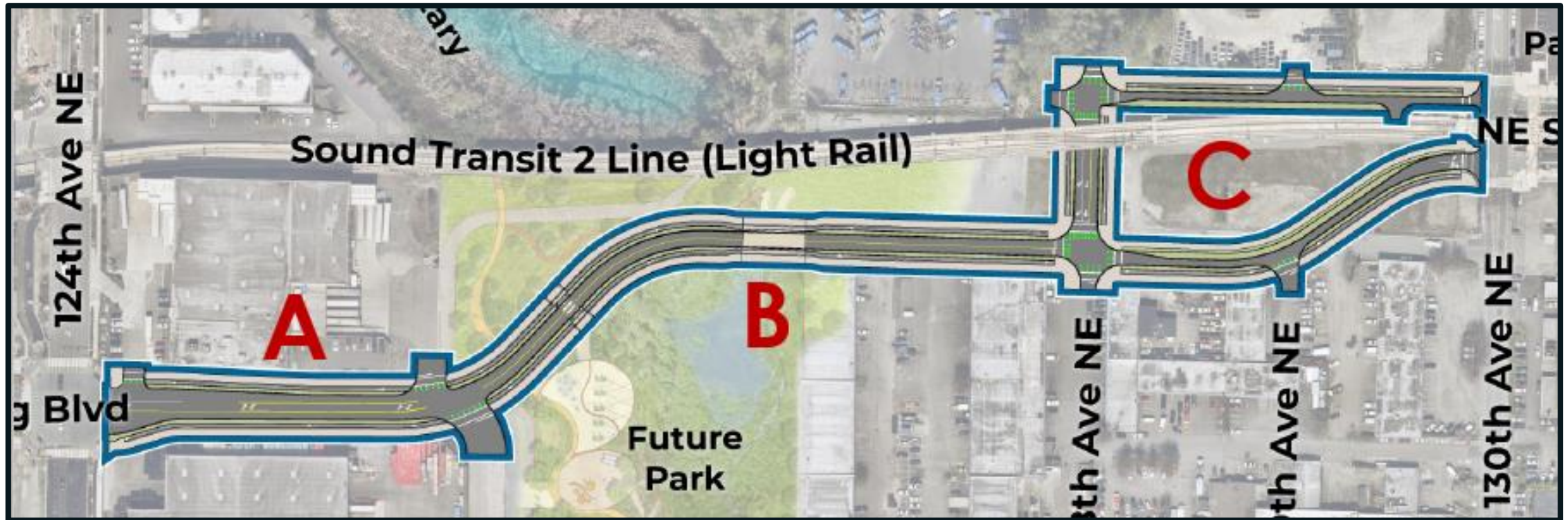


Separated Path Route from NE Spring Blvd to Downtown



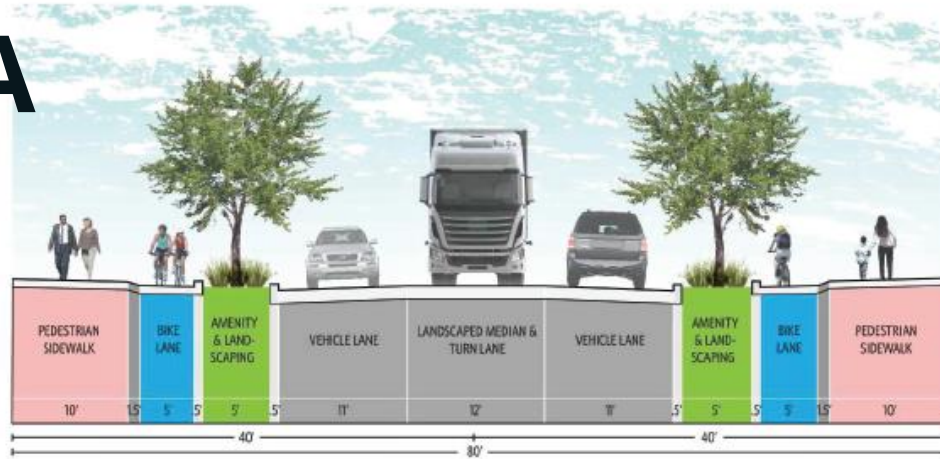
Mobility and Accessibility

- Section C – one-way couplet, ties to future streets & 130th Ave NE

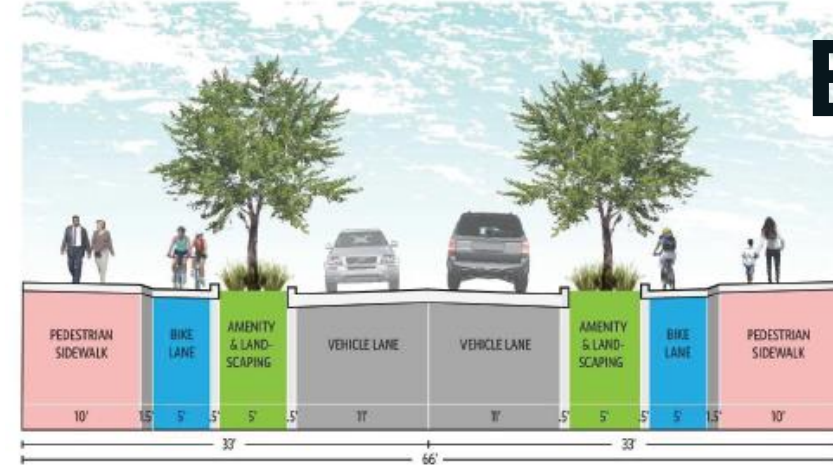

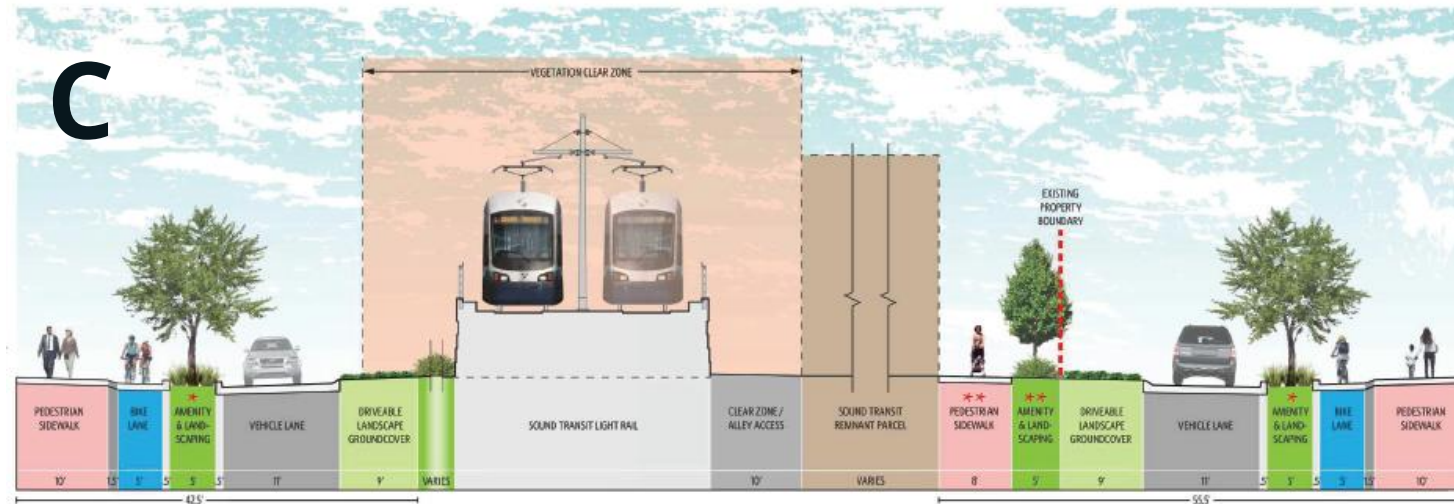

Safety and Security



- Separated design for vulnerable users;
- Project includes over 10 FHWA proven safety countermeasures



- Alternative to High Injury Network

Equity Focus Areas, outreach & benefit

- **Downtown Bellevue** – benefitting communities over the regional threshold: 62% people of color; 21% people with limited English proficiency; 7% older adults.
- **BelRed** – benefitting communities over the regional threshold: 43% people of color; 17% youth
- **Intersectionality benefits**
 - Downtown Bellevue - people with limited English and elderly
 - BelRed – people of color and youth

Equity and Outreach

- Reaching out to Equity Focus Areas:
 - Enhanced, targeted outreach plans during design (going out to where the communities live, work, and gather...).
 - Solicit outreach methods from communities themselves.
 - Assure design for all ages and abilities; universal wayfinding and signage.
