Introduce individuals to the planning process and profession at an early age.


Engage young people on a regular basis to provide input on PSRC's policies and programs.

Promote equity in the region by actively recruiting and engaging youth from diverse backgrounds.







Changes for 2024

Students will be required to complete a capstone at the end of the program.



Many students in 2023 cohort already had background knowledge of planning






