



Introducing PSRC's Equity Tracker

Racial and ethnic disparities in key quality of life indicators have persisted in the central Puget Sound region, with Black, Indigenous, and People of Color faring worse compared to White individuals. Robust data and information are essential to developing strategies to build an equitable region.

The Equity Tracker uses reliable and regularly updated data to identify disparities between people in different communities. It tracks performance in addressing inequities, holds PSRC and its partners accountable in advancing racial equity, and supports future policies and actions.

This resource is intended for policymakers, public agency staff and community members, and helps PSRC track progress on equity-related [VISION 2050](#) goals.
