## **Coordinated Mobility and Accessibility Committee Meeting Summary**

#### **Welcome and Introductions**

Jean Kim, PSRC, welcomed everyone at 9:30 a.m. and took a roll call of the membership in attendance.

#### **Approval of Meeting Summary**

The May 15, 2024 meeting summary was approved as presented.

#### **Discussion: Committee Operating Procedures and Membership Update**

Jean Kim, PSRC, shared the committee's Operating Procedures, which was revised based on the committee's feedback from the March and May meetings. Key updates to the operating procedures included the removal of committee leadership and membership. PSRC proposed to revise the membership to engage more diverse members from the region, including system users, create separate voting seats for tribal members, and reflect more universal terms throughout the membership. PSRC also proposed to add the non-voting partner membership to invite WSDOT Community Transportation Planners representing all counties in our region. The committee discussed before taking action to approve the updated <a href="CMAC Operating Procedures">CMAC Operating Procedures</a>.
