PSRC proposed to revise the membership to engage more diverse members from the region, including system users, create separate voting seats for tribal members, and reflect more universal terms throughout the membership. PSRC also proposed to add the non-voting partner membership to invite WSDOT Community Transportation Planners representing all counties in our region.
