### Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964



Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 states that "No person in the United States shall, on the ground of race, color, or national origin, be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be subjected to discrimination under any program or activity receiving Federal financial assistance."

# Purpose of Demographic Profile

### Compile demographic information for region

- Environmental justice populations (people of color, low-income)
- Language and Limited English Proficiency
- Additional equity populations
- Summary statistics and geographic distributions and patterns

### For purpose of:

- Informing environmental justice and equity analyses of disproportionate impacts
- Supporting effective public outreach and engagement of environmental justice and other equity populations






