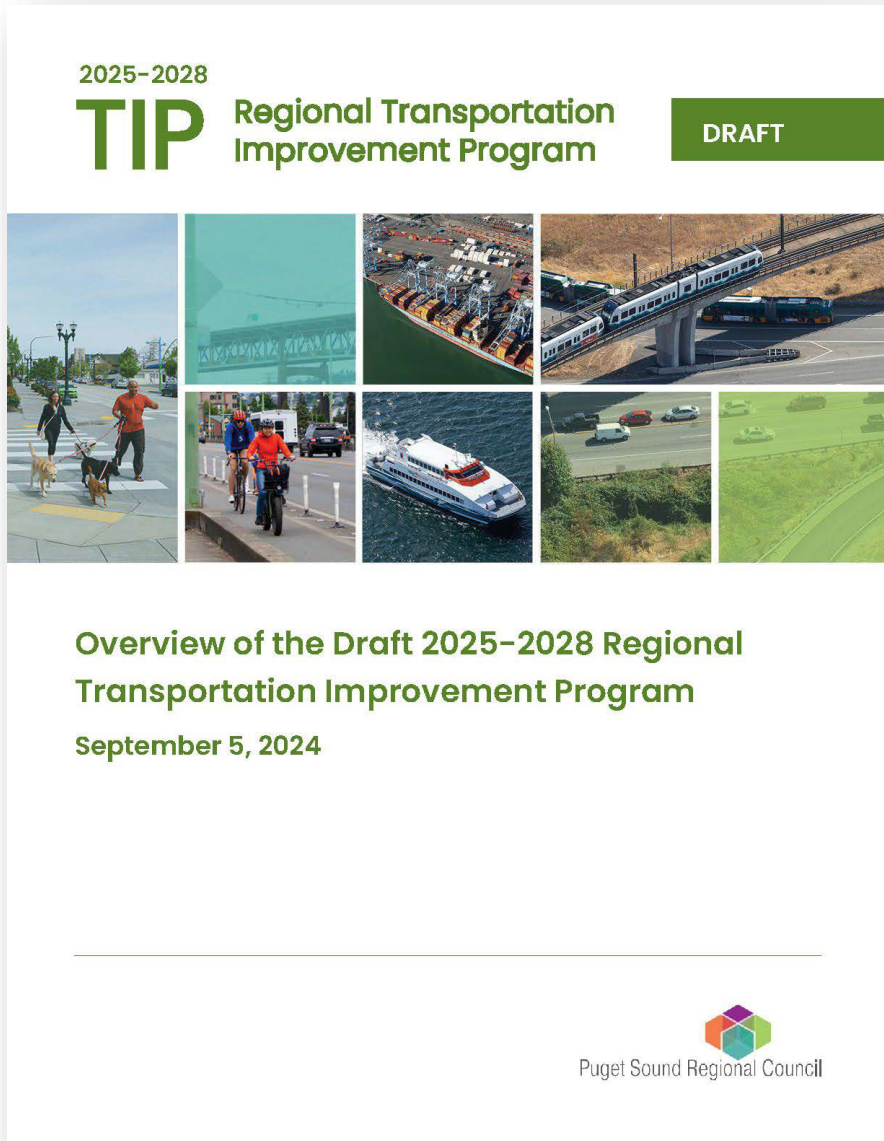

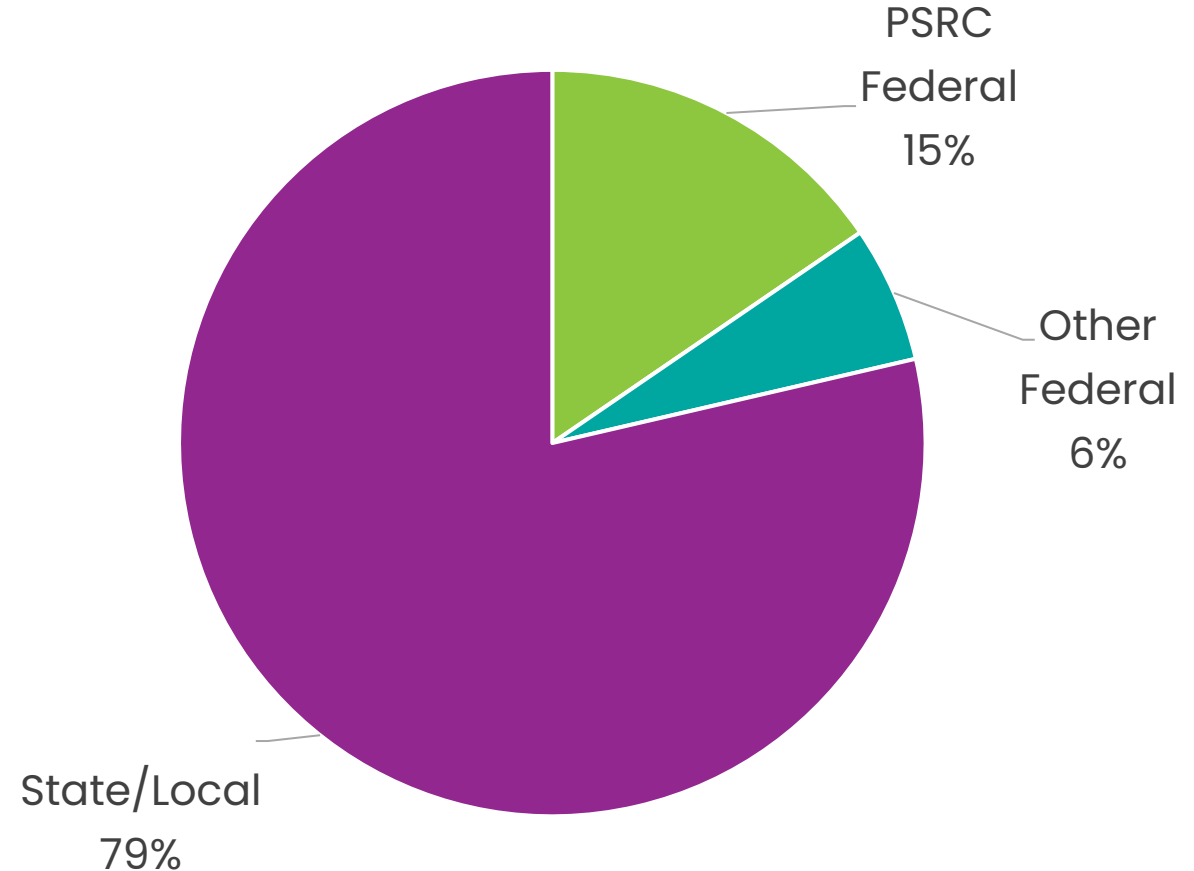


Planning & Programming Framework



Draft 2025–2028 Regional TIP

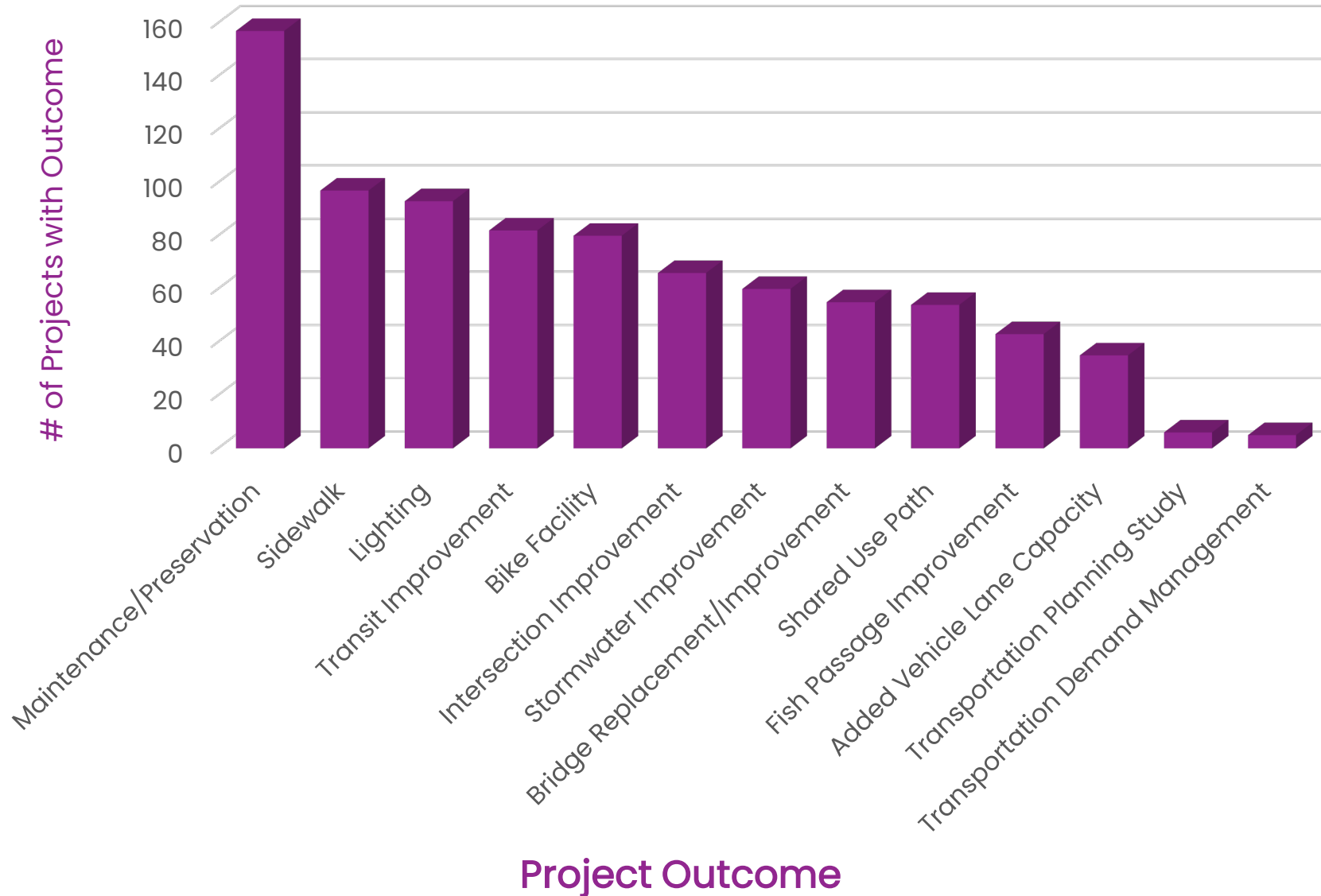
- Four-year snapshot
 - PSRC federal funds, other federal funds, state funds, local funds
- **\$9.6 billion** programmed
 - As of September 2024*
- Represents **~\$44 billion** in total project investments
- Includes detailed project information



** Final TIP submitted to WSDOT will include project amendments through October, and amounts will continue to be adjusted through the routine monthly amendment process*

Of 435 projects programmed, most include multiple outcomes

Summary of Public Comments

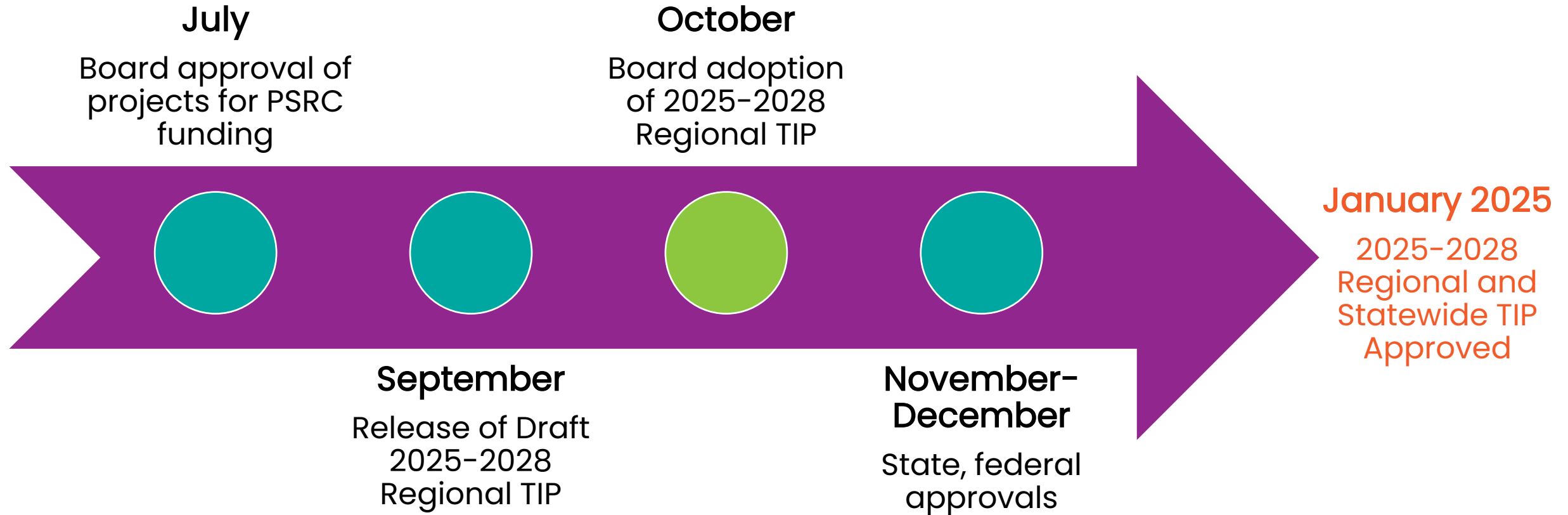


Two comments submitted as of October 1
