What is the project?

SVT currently provides services, seven days a week, for transit-dependent individuals within Snoqualmie Valley. We need small buses to do this.



Scope:

Provide replacement vehicles to sustain ADA accessible demand response services and deviated route services to specialized transportation populations and the general public in incorporated and unincorporated rural areas including North Bend, Snoqualmie, Fall City, Preston, Carnation, Duvall (King County) and Monroe (Snohomish County).



Background

Rural transportation since 2003 as a project of Mt. Si Senior Center

- Using a State Contractor
- WSDOT useful life is five (5) years, or 150,000 miles on these vehicle.
- Vehicles will replace four previous units, all past their useful life.
