#### **Welcome and Introductions**

Peter Heffernan, King County Metro, welcomed everyone at 10:00 a.m. Peter took roll call and confirmed the members and alternates present.

#### **Transportation Policy Board Debrief**

Colin Pippin-Timco, WSDOT, shared information about WSDOT's incorporation of transit integration into WSDOT's Mobility Report. Colin responded to committee member questions.

#### **Discussion: PSRC Transit Model Summit**

Stefan Coe and Brice Nichols, PSRC, shared information about PSRC's model and how it incorporates transit to identify future transit boardings and other metrics. Brant Lyerla from Sound Transit provided background on Sound Transit's model. Committee members and guests asked the presenters questions. Craig Helmann, PSRC, indicated that PSRC wants to ensure transit agencies understand the two different models since

outputs from each model are reported. In recent years, many other transit agencies' consultant teams have used the Sound Transit model as the basis for their long-range plans. PSRC's travel model is used for more comprehensive travel forecasting, not just for transit.

Instead, Jean provided background to the committee and answered questions in advance of a vote-by-email that is planned for mid-December.
