# Freight and Goods Transportation System

- FGTS classifies multimodal freight corridors in Washington State based on freight tonnage carried
- WSDOT updates the FGTS every two years to meet legislative requirements, guide freight investment decisions, and support planning

#### FGTS truck corridor classification

Classification	Annual tonnage	
T-1	> 10 million tons	FMSIB
T-2	4-10 million tons	Strategic Freight Corridors
T-3	300K-4 million tons	
T-4	100K-300K tons	
T-5	≥ 20K tons in 60 days	

## **2025 FGTS Request**

WSDOT is requesting FGTS classification data (T-1 to T-5), supporting truck volume data and estimated tonnage from cities, ports, and MPO/RTPOs:

- T-1 and T-2 Corridors: truck volume data and estimated tonnage not older than June 2021 is required. Data older than June 2021 will not qualify for T-1/T-2 designation.
- T-3 through T-5 Corridors: truck volume data and estimated tonnage not older than June 2021 is recommended.



## **Data Request timeline and process**

- February 7<sup>th</sup>: WSDOT sent out FGTS data collection requests to MPO/RTPOs
- February 20<sup>th</sup>: WSDOT hosts a technical webinar to provide guidance and address questions
- February May: MPO/RTPOs coordinate with cities and ports to gather data and complete data submission forms for respective jurisdictions/regions
- **No later than June 13<sup>th</sup>, MPO/RTPOs submit the completed data submission form for their region to WSDOT.**
