The East Portland Avenue project will carry out a grind & overlay of this principal arterial from the intersection at E 64th St to the Intersection at E 72nd St with channelization potentially extending beyond each intersection as needed. This is necessary maintenance and will extend the pavement life cycle and preserve the roadway, serving general, transit, and freight traffic for years to come. Sidewalks currently exist on both sides of Portland Ave to facilitate non-motorized use and this project will allow the City to improve accessibility and pedestrian crossings to meet the needs of all users and ADA compliance.
