- Which transportation needs shared in PSRC's presentation resonate most with you and the community you represent?
  - What are the biggest challenges when using public transit (e.g., buses, rail, ferries)?
  - What are the challenges with specialized transportation (e.g., paratransit, demand-response shuttles)?
  - What are the challenges with walking, biking, or rolling in your area?
  - Are there specific times of day, locations, or types of trips (e.g., medical, school, work, essential services) where transportation does not meet your or your community's needs?
- Are there any transportation challenges you or your community experience that were NOT reflected in the presentation?
- Is there any transportation need you want to make sure the region highlights in the Coordinated Mobility Plan?

After the breakout, PSRC staff will share a summary of each group's discussion with the full committee.

### **Coordinated Mobility and Accessibility Committee Meeting Summary**

#### **Welcome and Introductions**

Jean Kim, PSRC, welcomed everyone at 9:30 a.m. and took a roll call of the membership in attendance.

#### **Approval of Meeting Summary**

The January 15, 2025 meeting summary was approved as presented.

#### **Discussion: Coordinated Mobility Plan Current System Report Update**

Jean Kim, PSRC, presented a summary of the draft Coordinated Mobility Plan Current System Report. The report addresses usage and gaps in transit and specialized transportation available to serve priority populations in the region. CMAC members provided feedback on key findings. Jean mentioned that the interim report will be posted in spring 2025, which will then feed into the next Regional Transportation Plan and the Coordinated Mobility Plan.
