injuries and deaths between 2015–2023.

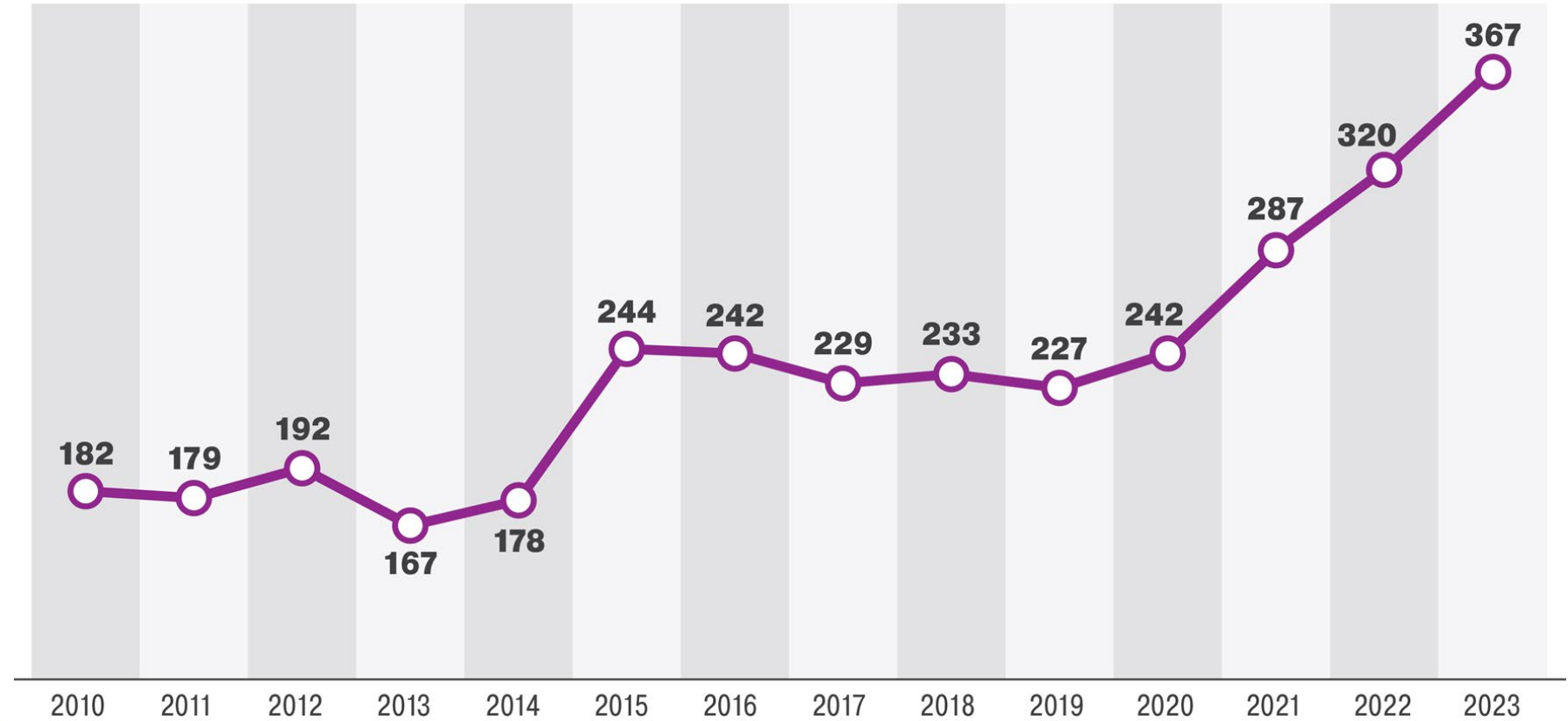
**1 in 16**

# The Regional Safety Action Plan

## IS A CALL TO ACTION

Use a Safe System Approach and leverage a toolbox of proven strategies, regional data and analysis, and best practices research to develop and build local action plans to address traffic safety.





## RECOMMENDED ACTION: Regional Safety Action Plan

### The General Assembly should:

1. Adopt the Regional Safety Action Plan in accordance with Resolution No. PSRC-A-202502 (Attachment A), which describes the document being adopted, gives the Executive Board authority to make minor future changes, and sets out the findings that support adoption of the plan; and
2. Direct staff to prepare, reproduce, and distribute the Regional Safety Action Plan document with any final minor corrections that may become necessary.
