


# ABOUT PNWER

- Approved by PNWER Executive Board in September 2023
- Inaugural Governance Meeting in March 2024
- Regional Tourism Listening Session at PNWER Annual Summit in July 2024

## **Goals of the RTC**

- Initial focus on regional readiness for the 2026 FIFA World Cup
- Work collaboratively toward the safety, efficiency, and ease of cross-border travel
- Spotlight our region as a leader of responsible, sustainable, and resilient tourism!

### **Governance Structure**

- Two representatives from each of the ten PNWER jurisdictions
  - One Elected and One Industry Representative
- Supported by a strategic Advisory Committee

Ambassador Cohen noted FIFA is an opportunity to showcase the world-class status of Seattle and Vancouver. Many visitors at FIFA are C-suite executives. Of the companies that relocated or were established in Vancouver since 2010, 80% had executives that attended the 2010 Olympic games.
