CALL TO ORDER AND ROLL CALL

The meeting was called to order at 10:02 a.m. by Councilmember Ed Prince, Chair.

COMMUNICATIONS AND PUBLIC COMMENT

There was no public comment.

CHAIR'S REPORT

Chair Prince had nothing to report.

DIRECTOR'S REPORT

Growth Management Director Paul Inghram welcomed the board and introduced PSRC's Director of Government Relations and Communications, Robin Koskey, who provided the board with an update on federal and state legislative actions. Mr. Inghram introduced the items on the agenda and mentioned the information items at the end of the agenda packet.

CONSENT AGENDA

 a. Approve Minutes of Growth Management Policy Board Meeting held April 3, 2025.

<u>ACTION</u>: It was moved and seconded (Sadalge/Marine) to adopt the Consent Agenda. The motion passed.

ACTION ITEM: RECOMMEND CERTIFICATION OF COMPREHENSIVE PLANS FOR COVINGTON, EDGEWOOD, ENUMCLAW, FIRCREST, GRANITE FALLS, KENMORE, KIRKLAND, LAKE STEVENS, MILTON, REDMOND, SAMMAMISH, SHORELINE, SKYKOMISH, AND SNOHOMISH

PSRC staff presented the board with the recommended certifications of comprehensive plans for Covington, Edgewood, Enumclaw, Fircrest, Granite Falls, Kenmore, Kirkland, Lake Stevens, Milton, Redmond, Sammamish, Shoreline, Skykomish, and Snohomish.

ACTION: It was moved and seconded (M Stuart/Solomon) to recommend the Executive Board certify that the transportation-related provisions in the Covington, Edgewood, Enumclaw, Fircrest, Granite Falls, Kenmore, Kirkland, Lake Stevens, Milton, Redmond, Sammamish, Shoreline, Skykomish, and Snohomish 2024 Comprehensive Plans conform to the Growth Management Act and are substantially consistent with multicounty planning policies and the Regional Transportation Plan. The motion passed.

The recommendation will be brought to the Executive Board for action on June 26, 2025.

DISCUSSION ITEM: A NEW MISSING MIDDLE? THE DISAPPEARANCE OF MODERATE SIZED HOUSING

The board was briefed by PSRC Associate Planner Eric Clute on follow-up data from the 2024 Regional Housing Strategy monitoring process. PSRC's recent housing trend on housing production by tenure and unit size shows a gap in producing moderately sized units for both the rental and ownership markets. PSRC will provide an annual update on the housing data monitoring efforts in the fall 2025. Board discussion included current housing production in contrast to permitting for future building, homeowner incentives, and interest in seeing the data at the county level.

DISCUSSION ITEM: TRANSFER OF DEVELOPMENT RIGHTS WORKSHOP

The board was briefed on the Department of Commerce's workshop that will help jurisdictions develop and update Transfer of Development Rights (TDR) programs and Land Conservation and Local Infrastructure Programs (LCLIP). TDR is a market-based mechanism that supports voluntary transfer of development rights from areas where developing is discouraged, and moved to places the community would like to grow. LCLIP provides a financial incentive for eligible cities in King, Pierce and Snohomish counties to participate in TDR. The workshop is planned for June 11 to go over the guidance resources and answer questions. Board discussion included questions on interjurisdictional TDR programs and incentives for jurisdictions to participate in the programs.
