# 2025 State Legislative Session



- Passed Operating, Capital and Transportation Budgets
- Revenue bills passed raise **\$9.4b** over 4 years to address budget deficit
- Transportation revenue – gas tax, diesel tax, vehicle registration, sales and use taxes, other fee increases

# Revenue Forecast

- Revenue down \$490m in FY 25–27 and \$638m in FY 27–29
- US & WA economies slowing, impacts of tariffs, federal employment/funding, geopolitical conflict, lower spending and higher interest and inflation rates
- New revenue adopted by legislature raises \$8b over 4 years creating a slight budget savings
- No special session – yet



# Transportation Revenue Forecast



- \$11m increase from March 2025 for FY 23–25
- \$2.78b increase for FY 25–29
- Legislative changes are major driver of revenue changes
