Jean Kim, PSRC, welcomed everyone at 9:30 a.m. and took a roll call of the membership in attendance.

Discussion: Key Transportation Needs of Priority Populations

Jean Kim and Erin Hogan, PSRC, presented a summary of transportation needs identified through prior CMAC meetings, a Mentimeter survey, community engagement, and other sources such as local needs assessments and surveys. Erin provided key findings from various engagement activities and surveys. Then, Jean shared a comparison of different needs expressed by various stakeholders and community members representing the Coordinated Mobility Plan's priority population. Staff facilitated a discussion to determine whether the compiled list of needs required clarification or reframing. The committee members were also invited to share any missing or underrepresented transportation needs. CMAC provided feedback, and staff made notes for future revision.
