Alex Krieg, Sound Transit, welcomed everyone at 10:00 a.m. Gil Cerise, PSRC took roll call and confirmed the members and alternates present.

Approval of Meeting Summary

Action: FTA Funding Allocation Requests

Gil Cerise, PSRC, provided a brief presentation explaining King County Metro's funding allocation request. The committee unanimously recommended King County Metro's funding allocation request for Transportation Policy Board (TPB) action.

Discussion: Regional Transportation Plan Development

Kelly McGourty, PSRC, provided an update on discussions with the TPB on the development of an RTP financial strategy that closes the gap between revenues and expenses. Kelly shared information on potential choices the board could take to close this gap, including one that affects transit agency plans: cutting back on planned service expansion for local transit. Committee members asked questions. PSRC staff recommended that agencies monitor discussions at the July board meeting since it will inform PSRC's modeling over the summer.
