Kelly McGourty, PSRC, briefed the committee on the ongoing work related to the RTP Financial Strategy and outlined the next steps for the active transportation elements of the RTP. This included an overview of the proposed expenditures and revenues for the plan, as well as an outline of the current board discussions addressing the financial gap. Kelly highlighted issues of specific relevance to active transportation, such as the high percentage of regional trail projects with low plan consistency scores and potential future system metrics pedestrian and bicycle travel.
