



- Following up with several jurisdictions regarding housing requirements



City of Buckley Comprehensive Plan





Plan Highlight: Supports preservation of historic buildings and infill development in downtown Buckley


- Standard comments: Climate, housing implementation

City of Fife Comprehensive Plan



Population: 11,320

Regional Geography: HCT Communities

Plan Highlights: Includes strong focus on downtown redevelopment ahead of light rail service and cooperation with adjacent municipalities and the Puyallup Tribe

- Standard comments: Climate requirements, housing implementation, multimodal level of service standards
- Land Use and Annexation: Continue to coordinate with Pierce County on Potential Annexation Areas.



Plan Highlights: Strong policies to support water quality, habitat, and shoreline resources; clear policies and implementation actions to support housing affordability

- Standard comments: Climate requirements, housing implementation, multimodal level of service standards
- Transportation: Coordinate with WSDOT to address issues on state highway facilities

City of Woodinville Comprehensive Plan



Population: 13,900

Regional Geography: HCT Communities

Plan Highlights: A new Climate Element based on the city's 2023 climate action plan; strong public engagement to support downtown development

- Standard comments: Climate requirements, housing implementation, multimodal level of service standards
- Regional Growth Strategy: Recommend reevaluating growth targets and transportation impacts if high growth trends continue
- Transportation: Include a reassessment strategy

Population: 228,400


Regional Geography: Metro Cities

Plan Highlights: An equity analysis on the plan, focus on growth within the city's regional and mixed-use centers, transportation element with a tiered, long-term project list and projected revenue for the 20-year planning period

- Standard comments: Climate requirements, housing implementation, multimodal level of service standards
- Centers: Complete the Tideflats MIC subarea plan

City of Tukwila Comprehensive Plan







Population: 22,960

Regional Geography: Core City

Plan Highlight: Community Character chapter, goals around addressing food deserts in low-income areas

- Standard comments: Climate requirements, housing implementation, multimodal level of service standards
- Housing: Update plan to reflect revised emergency housing capacity
- Environment: Reduce impacts to vulnerable populations
- Transportation: Include further analysis of revenue/expenditures for 20-year planning period


Staff Recommendation

Recommend the Executive Board certify that the transportation-related provisions of the Bremerton, Buckley, Everett, Fife, Poulsbo, Tacoma, Tukwila, and Woodinville comprehensive plans conform to the Growth Management Act and are substantially consistent with multicounty planning policies and the Regional Transportation Plan.
